



# FAFEN Retail Price Monitor

*A Report Based on Prices Collected at Retail Outlets in 136 Towns of 87 Districts in Pakistan*

**June 2010**

## **Introduction and Methodology**

The Free and Fair Election Network (FAFEN) has launched a nationwide initiative to monitor governance processes under its Democratic Governance Program in line with its mandate to strengthen all forms of democratic accountabilities in Pakistan. Objective information about governance processes is vital to encourage informed engagement of citizenry with elected and public institutions for progressive outputs. FAFEN Governance Monitoring aims at enriching the public discourse and debate on governance and developing research-based recommendations for reforms.

FAFEN advocates for transparency, accountability, responsiveness, representativeness and public participation as essential elements of democratic governance to enhance the output, efficiency and effectiveness of all elected and public institutions.

Price stability, particularly of essential commodities, is one indicator of good governance. Although the government issues periodic price indices such as Consumer Price Index (CPI), Sensitive Price Index (SPI) and Wholesale Price Index (WPI), there is dearth of independent, objective information on the prices of essential commodities in the country. There has also been concern that government price indices do not reflect the actual inflationary trends that consumers face in the market.

FAFEN Retail Price Monitor is an effort to fill this information gap through monthly collection of retail prices of 69 items categorized in 12 commodity groups in order to inspire public dialogue and as a contribution towards targeted interventions and reforms. FAFEN Governance Monitors collect prices of commodities, whose quality and quantity are specified, on standardized forms at retail outlets in 150 National Assembly constituencies of 106 districts across the country on the 10th of every month. All information received at the FAFEN Secretariat is verified through multiple sources for authenticity and accuracy.

FAFEN Retail Price Monitor is based on non-probability sampling, and its findings should not be considered national or provincial generalizations. However, FAFEN's outreach across the country allows it to access most districts as well as urban and rural areas. Standardized methodology is applied across Pakistan to draw information in a uniform way. Retail Price Monitor reports provide data analysis and inferences only for the monitored prices within the sample. These reports are meant to present to relevant stakeholders a consolidated and current price situation in order to inspire public dialogue and as a contribution towards targeted interventions and reforms.

However, FAFEN's unique methodology continues to evolve. Any inaccuracies that may be noticed in the data or suggestions for improvement in the methodology can be sent to the email address at the end of this report.

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## **Summary**

During June 2010, FAFEN Governance Monitors collected prices of 69 commodities and services at retail outlets in 136 National Assembly constituencies in 87 districts in the four provinces, Federally Administrated Tribal Areas (FATA) and Islamabad Capital Territory (ICT).

The prices of some frequently used vegetables (potato and garlic), pulses (moong and mash), basmati rice and few condiments (coriander, powdered salt, turmeric and red chillies) registered a significant increase in June 2010 as compared to their prices in May 2010. The prices of potato and turmeric that registered a high increase in May continued to rise nationally in June 2010, further increasing by 13% and 30%, respectively. Other Important food items registering increase in prices nationally in June include moong pulse (13%), basmati rice (4%), salt powder (9%), garlic (6%), mash pulse (8%), red chili powder (14%), coriander (7%), green tea (23%), mustard oil (7%), desi ghee (3%) and fresh milk, vegetable ghee and oil (1% each). Among fast moving consumer goods (FMCGs), toothpaste prices increased by 8% at the national level. Price of over-the-counter medicinal tablet Buscopan increased by 6% nationally. Among services, the prices of blood test increased by 3% in June as compared to May 2010. The price of LPG increased by 5% in June as compared to its price in May 2010.



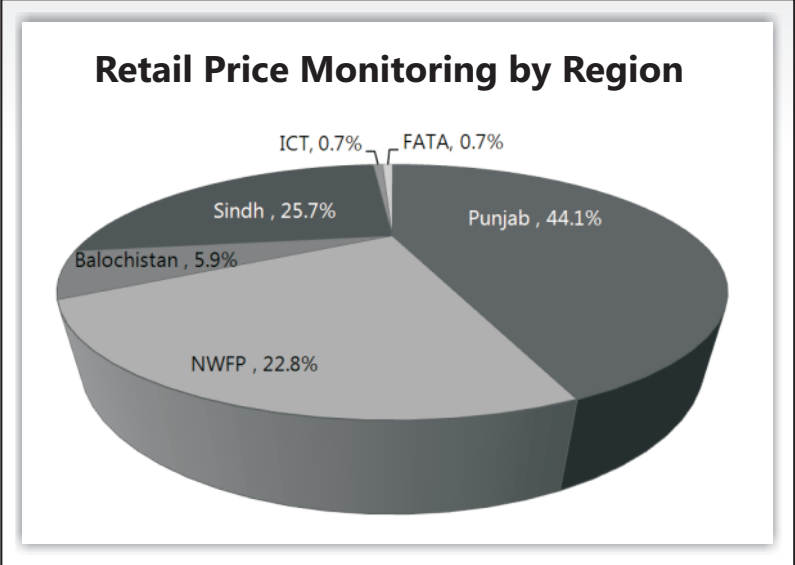
While 41 consumer commodities and services registered price increases, as many as 27 consumer items were available on relatively cheaper prices in June as compared to May. In Punjab, prices of 41 commodities and services registered increases, as did 44 commodities in Sindh, 39 in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, 38 in Balochistan and 16 in FATA.

Consumers paid relatively less to purchase onion (price decrease of 10%), mango (11%), orange (15%), chicken broiler (6%), petrol (7%), diesel (2%), kerosene oil (4%) and CNG (2%), in June as compared to what they had to pay in May 2010. In FMCGs, bath soap and washing soap registered a decrease of 2% each while washing powder was available on 3% less price in June as compared to the preceding month. Some diagnostic tests (urine and sugar 6% each and pregnancy test 7%) were also relatively cheaper in June as compared to May 2010.

There was a wide regional variance in terms of changes in the prices of some essential commodities. For instance, the price of tomatoes witnessed a nationwide decrease of 3% in June 2010 – despite the fact that it registered quite a significant increase of 62% in Sindh and 23% in Balochistan – because the price of this commodity went down as much as 43% in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, 46% in FATA and 8% in Punjab. FATA and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa are enjoying tomato production season. Punjab's tomato harvesting season has just ended, and the commodity is out of season in Balochistan and Sindh.

Mango prices were down in Sindh by 21%, and by 13% in Punjab due to peak harvesting season in these provinces but it shot up in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa by 3 percent. Khyber Pakhtunkhwa's contribution to the national production of this prime summer fruit is negligible. Similarly, the price of fish (Raho) increased in Punjab (12%), Sindh (8%) and Balochistan (44%) but it actually came down in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa by 2%. The price of pregnancy test all over the country decreased but it actually increased by one-fifth of the May price in FATA.

The price of green tea increased in Sindh by 58% followed by Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (35%) and FATA (20%). However, its increase remained nominal in Punjab (6%) as it is a less frequently consumed item in the province. Garlic prices increased all over the country by 6%, but FATA residents had to pay double the price of this commodity in June as compared to what they were paying in May 2010. Mustard oil price also doubled in FATA. The price of basmati rice (broken) increased mildly nationwide by 4%, but FATA residents had to pay 29% more to purchase this commodity in June as compared to May 2010.

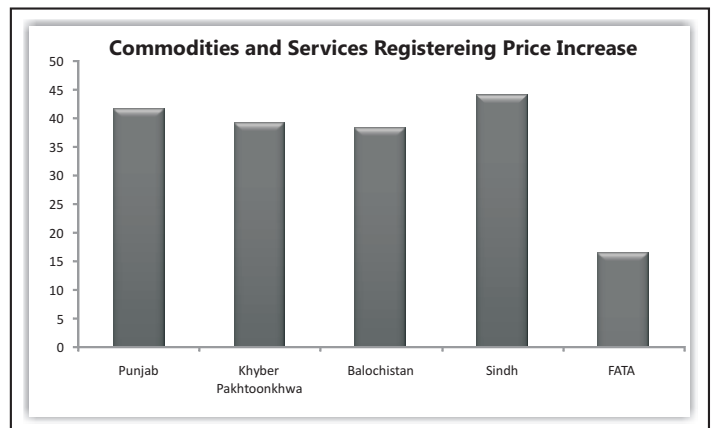


## Findings

FAFEN's detailed findings are categorized in three sections. The first section deals with prices of commodities that increased in June 2010 as compared to their prices in May 2010. The second section deals with prices of commodities that decreased in June as compared to May. The third section gives a comparison between commodity prices collected by the Federal Bureau of Statistics (FBS) on June 10, 2010, for their Sensitive Price Index and prices collected by FAFEN the same day.

### 1. Commodity Prices Registering Increase

In Punjab, prices of 41 commodities and services increased, as did 44 commodities in Sindh, 39 in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, 38 in Balochistan and 16 in FATA. **See Annex 1 for details by commodity and service in 87 districts monitored by FAFEN.**





**Table 1: Five Highest Price Increases in Punjab**

In Punjab, the price of potato, continued to increase in June. It registered an increase of 31.4% in June 2010 as compared to its price in May. Price of bananas per dozen increased by 19.6%, turmeric 17.6% and moong pulse (washed) 13.6% in June as compared to their prices in May 2010.

In Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, turmeric registered the highest increase of 62.7% in June 2010 as compared to its price in May. This was followed by unbranded butter whose price increased by 39.6%, green tea 34.5%, toothpaste 16.9% and red chili powder 14.8%.

In Balochistan, turmeric per kilogram registered the highest price increase of 46.2% in June 2010 as compared to its price in May. This was followed by fish whose price increased by 43.7%, orange by 34.6% increase, urine test 29.6%, and sugar test 26.8%.

In Sindh, tomatoes per kilogram registered the highest increase at 62.4% in June 2010 as compared to its price in May. This was followed by green tea whose price registered a 57.7% increase, coriander 30.2%, turmeric 27.8% and red chilies (whole) 21.2% increase.

In FATA, mustard oil and garlic prices doubled in June as compared to their prices in May 2010. The price of bananas per dozen increased by 33.3%, rice basmati (broken) 28.6% and unbranded butter 25%.

## 2. Commodity Prices Registering Decrease

The prices of 27 commodities and services registered a decrease in June 2010 nationwide as compared to their prices in May 2010. Oranges registered the greatest percentage price decrease of 14.6%, followed by mango (10.7%), onion (10.4%) and petrol (6.7%).

### 3. FBS-FAFEN Data Comparison

The FBS collects prices of 53 commodities for its weekly Sensitive Price Index. Of these 53 commodities, 36 are included in FAFEN's Retail Price Monitor. Overall FAFEN collects prices of 69 commodities and services in more than 90 districts as compared to the FBS coverage area that includes only 53 markets in 17 districts.

Table 8 shows a comparison of prices collected by FAFEN on June 10, 2010, with FBS prices collected on the same date, in 15 districts common to both studies. The table shows variations in the two data sets. For example, in Islamabad, FAFEN price monitoring suggests that 13 commodities were more expensive in June than the prices collected by FBS and 17 items were less expensive than reported by FBS. The opposite is apparent in Karachi, where FAFEN found twice as many (26) commodities to be more expensive and fewer (10) items to be less expensive than reported by FBS.

In general, FAFEN found more commodities to be more expensive in eight districts, namely Gujranwala, Sialkot, and Sargodha (Punjab), Karachi and Larkana (Sindh), Peshawar and Bannu (KPK), and Quetta (Balochistan). FBS found more items to be more expensive in seven districts, namely Islamabad (ICT), Rawalpindi, Lahore, Faisalabad, Multan, (Punjab), and Hyderabad and Sukkur (Sindh). 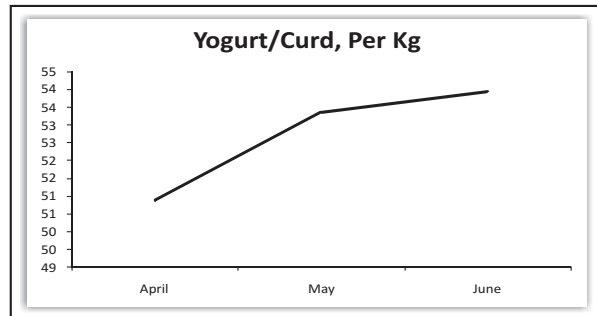
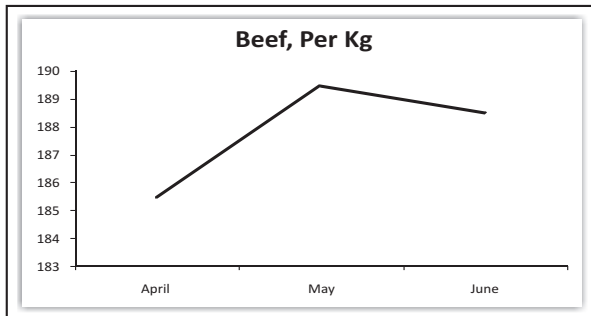

- Deployed more than 18,829 trained, neutral Election Day observers nationwide to watch the February 18, 2008 polls and 264 long-term observers to monitor the pre-election process.
- Fielded long-term observers nationwide and published 19 pre-election reports.
- For the February 18, 2008, General Elections, FAFEN conducted 260 simultaneous parallel Vote Tabulations (PVTs)- the largest effort in the world.
- Conducted its first survey, Constituents Aspirations Survey, in December 2008 with a sample size of 3,124 respondents to get the description of the state of public opinion and also to get a deeper understanding of the values, attitudes and beliefs of people living in the constituencies.
- Conducted a mapping of both large and small organizations engaged in human rights within Pakistan.
- Observed general elections at Gilgit Baltistan in 2009 and by elections in various constituencies of the Punjab, Balochistan and NWFP in 2010.
- Published Parliamentary Session wise and Joint Session reports under the Parliamentary Watch Project.

FAFEN continues to implement robust programs in-between elections related to monitoring parliamentary affairs, connecting constituents to their elected representatives, monitoring the performance of public and elected institutions and advocating electoral and democratic reforms. FAFEN is also monitoring political and electoral violence, peace activities and promoting active citizenry through ongoing civic education activities across the country. FAFEN is currently implementing Democratic Governance Program in 150 National Assembly constituencies in 106 district across Pakistan.
