



FAFEN'S REVIEW OF PRELIMINARY REPORT OF THE DELIMITATION AND LIST OF CONSTITUENCIES FOR NATIONAL AND PROVINCIAL ASSEMBLIES



June 17, 2022

The preliminary report and list of National and Provincial Assemblies' constituencies published by the Election Commission of Pakistan (ECP) has reinforced the need for improvements in the legal framework that governs the delimitations of electoral constituencies in the country in an effort to minimize variance of population among electoral constituencies and ensure that they comprise an equal population in the spirit of just and fair representation and contestation.

While FAFEN acknowledges improvements in the contents and quality of the preliminary report as compared to the reports of the last delimitation published in 2018, it urges the political parties to take cognizance of inadequacies in the relevant sections of the Elections Act, 2017 that restrict the ECP from delimiting electoral constituencies of equal sizes or keeping the variance of population among them under 10 percent as required by the law. The government has rightly repeated its emphasis on electoral reforms which must be pursued in the spirit of greater consultation with all political parties including those which may not have a presence in the elected assemblies but are politically relevant. The election system will not improve without substantial improvements in the delimitation process to prevent an imbalance of population across electoral precincts and

CONTEXT

Election Commission is delimiting the constituencies for elections to the National and Provincial Assemblies after the official publication of the results of 6th Population and Housing Census 2017. The latest exercise was compelled by the effect of Section 17(2) of the Elections Act, 2017 which stipulates that the Commission shall delimit constituencies after every census officially published. Last general elections (GE) were held on the electoral delimitation conducted on the basis of provisional census results under a one-time arrangement provided in the Constitution (25th Amendment) Act, 2018. However, these delimitations could only be used for the purposes of GE-2018 and subsequent by-elections. The ECP initiated the processes for fresh delimitation in April 2022 and published the preliminary report of delimitation of National and Provincial Assemblies' constituencies on May 31, 2022 as per Section 21 of the Elections Act, 2017.

FAFEN's review of the Preliminary Report of Delimitation and the List of Constituencies aims to furnish initial recommendations for improvement in the quality of delimitations as well as to encourage an informed public discourse on this critical aspect of the electoral process in Pakistan.



ensure representation of all geographical, linguist, ethnic and religious diversity in the elected bodies. Delimitation is one of the most critical mechanisms of allocation of political power to people by the state, and therefore, must be just, fair and transparent.

Of particular concern is Section 20 (1) of the Elections Act, 2017 which lays out principles of delimitation for the ECP and states, "All constituencies for general seats shall, as far as practicable, be delimited having regard to the distribution of population in geographically compact areas, physical features, existing boundaries of administrative units, facilities of communication and public convenience and other cognate factors to ensure homogeneity in the creation of constituencies." The major reason for population variance, including those that exceed the permissible 10 percent variance, is the requirement of consideration of existing boundaries of administrative units, which are not defined in the law.

This is further compounded by the rules particularly Rule 10 (4) and the first proviso of Rule 10 (5) devised by the ECP for carving out the constituencies as per Section 239 of the Elections Act, 2017. Since, the ECP

has no control over the creation of administrative units, restricting it to respect the integrity of their existing boundaries creates unresolvable issues that crop up in the shape of constituencies with population variance beyond the legally permissible threshold. This also provides an opportunity for the executive to influence any delimitation process by creating or redefining the boundaries of an existing administrative unit.

Through an analysis of the preliminary report of delimitation, FAFEN has identified at least 82 (31 percent) National Assembly and 88 (15 percent) Provincial Assemblies' constituencies (See Annexures I-A and I-B for complete lists) which have a population that varies more than 10 percent of their respective regional quotas per seat (average population in a constituency) calculated under Rules 8 (1) and 8 (4) of the Election Rules, 2017. As many as 63 constituencies have 11 percent to 20 percent variance from the respective quota per seat, 12 constituencies have 21 percent to 30 variance and 11 constituencies have above 30 percent variance. The following table shows the number of such constituencies in each region and Assembly:

NA-39 Bannu is the largest National Assembly constituency with a population of more than 1.2 million which is 1.5 times bigger than the average constituency population in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (788,933), and almost three times the population of the smallest constituency NA-42 Tank i.e. 427,044. As many as eight NA constituencies have more than one million population. Intra-regional disparities in the population size of NA constituencies are more widespread in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa than in any other province. Around 48 percent of the NA constituencies in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa have above 10 percent variance from the respective quota. Similarly, 38 percent Sindh, 24

percent Punjab and 19 percent Balochistan constituencies have more than 10 percent variance from their respective quotas. Amongst Provincial Assemblies, Balochistan has the highest percentage of constituencies (55 percent) that vary more than 10 percent from the provincial average population per constituency. The province is followed by KP (26 percent), Sindh (14 percent), and Punjab (four percent). The following table shows the largest and smallest constituencies in the National and Provincial Assemblies along with their quota per seat and variance percentage.

The procedure provided in the proviso under Rule 10 of the Elections Rules 2017 for determining the population variance among constituencies does not truly reflect the spirit of the provisions of section 20 (3) which explicitly states that the population of constituencies of 'an

Assembly' shall not ordinarily exceed ten percent. The said proviso under Rule 10 provides for only intra-district variance check, thus providing room for wide discrepancies amongst the constituencies of the same Assembly. The Election Commission defines the legally



permissible variance threshold of 10 percent as a band of plus/minus five percent of the average constituency population. Any variance higher than five percent above and below the average size is considered a deviation worthy of written reasons. While the ECP's measure to keep the variance at a minimum despite restrictive legislation must be acknowledged, its application within individual districts may not be practical.

If determined as per the procedure laid out in Rule 10, the population sizes of 11 National Assembly and 92 Provincial Assembly constituencies do not fall within the 10 percent variance band as defined by the ECP under the said Rule (See Annexure II-A and II-B for the

complete lists). Unlike the 2018 delimitation reports, the current preliminary report has recorded the reasons for the variance in several constituencies, still an exhaustive list of the reasons for each of 103 National and Provincial Assemblies' constituencies is still missing. The reasons provided in the report include measures to: avoid bifurcation of administrative divisions; ensure compactness and homogeneity of the constituencies; and, limit the population variance within constituencies of a district at a minimum. The following table shows the number of national and provincial assemblies' constituencies that have a intra-district population variance outside 10 percent variance band as determined by the ECP:

In furtherance of section 20(1)'s provision for according regard to the existing boundaries of the administrative units during the delimitation, the Rule 10 (4) stipulates that the constituency for an Assembly shall not ordinarily extend to more than one district except in

exceptional circumstances for reasons to be recorded by the Delimitation Committee. Moreover, the provisos under Rule 10 (4) bar the Delimitation Committees from breaking *patwar* circles or *tapedar* circles in rural areas and census circles in urban areas. However, the reasons

recorded in the preliminary report show that the delimitation committees have conveniently regarded various other administrative units such as local governments and tehsils while delimiting the constituencies. This situation warrants that the Elections Act 2017 provide for a specific administrative unit in order to avoid arbitrary application of mind by the delimitation committees and the commission as this may lead to unnecessary and avoidable litigation.

FAFEN also identified that the preliminary report of delimitation has altered the territorial limits of as many as 156 National Assembly constituencies as compared to 2018 delimitations (See Annexure III-A) while six constituencies of the erstwhile FATA have been merged with other constituencies and 110 constituencies have not been affected during the recent exercise. Similarly, 46 out of 51 Balochistan Assembly constituencies, 72 out of 115 KP Assembly constituencies, 242 out of 297 Punjab Assembly constituencies, and 50 out of 130 Sindh Assembly constituencies underwent territorial changes (See Annexure III-B). The preliminary report, however, does not provide explicit reasons for the territorial changes in the composition of the constituencies although the population figures of provisional and officially published census results remain almost unchanged. This may encourage public petitions for further explanations of these changes and thus increasing unnecessary judicial load on the commission and litigations in the courts.

Post-2018 alterations in the districts' boundaries in Balochistan and Sindh has led to some changes in the districts' share of the seats in National and Provincial Assemblies. The Balochistan government created three new districts including Chaman, Duki, and Surab while the Sindh government bifurcated Karachi West into Karachi West and Kemari districts. Moreover, the number of seats allocated to erstwhile FATA districts also changed in the fresh delimitation as the sunset clause 3A of Article 51 would become inoperative after the dissolution of the current Assemblies.

There also exist discrepancies in the population of multiple constituencies and their respective districts. In at least three districts, the census population of the districts is less than the overall population allocated to the constituencies of these districts. On the other side, there are seven instances where the census population of districts is more than the population allocated to the constituencies of the respective districts. Overall, there are 1,422 fewer voters allocated to National Assembly constituencies in Punjab and 10,071 in Balochistan. If these discrepancies are not reconciled in the final report of the delimitation, those unaccounted for in the preliminary report may be deprived of any representation in the Assemblies. The following table shows the district-wise or constituency-wise list of discrepancies in the population:

RECOMMENDATIONS

FAFEN recommends that the parliamentary and political parties may consider reviewing the application of various delimitation principles provided in section 20(1) of the Elections Act 2017 in light of the ongoing and previous delimitation exercises. The reform must emphasize the principles of inclusion and equality to ensure representation of all geographical, linguist, ethnic and religious diversity in the elected bodies, rather than safeguarding the integrity of administrative units which are determined by the executive. This condition under the existing law restricts the Election Commission from containing the variance amongst constituencies of an Assembly to a minimum (i.e. 10 percent) and thus ensuring equal-sized constituencies. Similarly, the cognate factors must also be defined in section 20 (1) to minimize the discretionary space available to delimitation committees.

However, these are long-term reforms that need broader parliamentary consultations and approvals. In

the short term, FAFEN recommends that the provisions of Rule 10 be brought in conformity with the section 20(3) of the Elections Act 2017 to ensure that the population sizes of the constituencies do not vary more than 10 percent across an Assembly. Currently, the first proviso under Rule 10 (5) provides for calculating a district average of the population per seat to work out the variance among the constituencies. This proviso may be amended in a manner that determination of variance among population of the constituencies is based on an assembly-wide average of the population per seat. This amendment would help the Election Commission to strike a balance between the respect for administrative units and the population size of the constituencies as well as to provide public a true picture of population disparities among the constituencies, reinforcing the need for long-term reforms.
