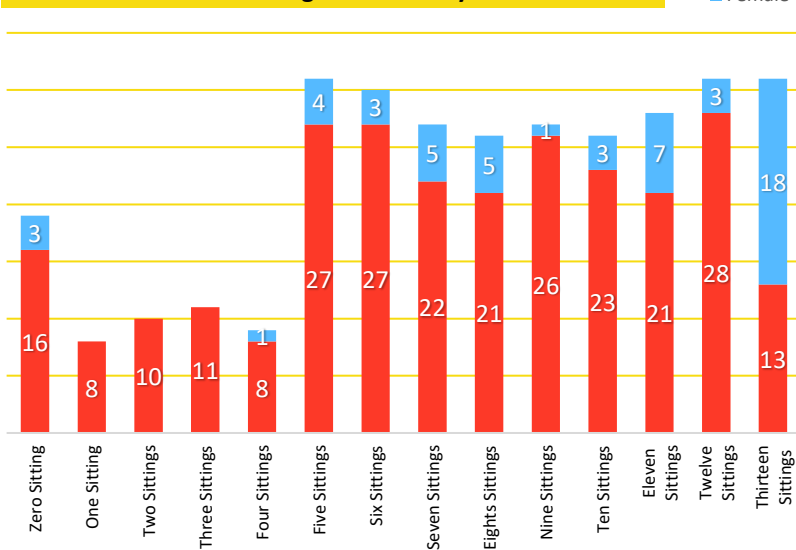

As many as 31 Members of National Assembly (10 percent) attended all sittings, whereas 19 (six percent) did not attend any sitting throughout the reporting session. Following chart shows the gender-disaggregated number of lawmakers grouped by the number of sittings they attended during the reporting session:

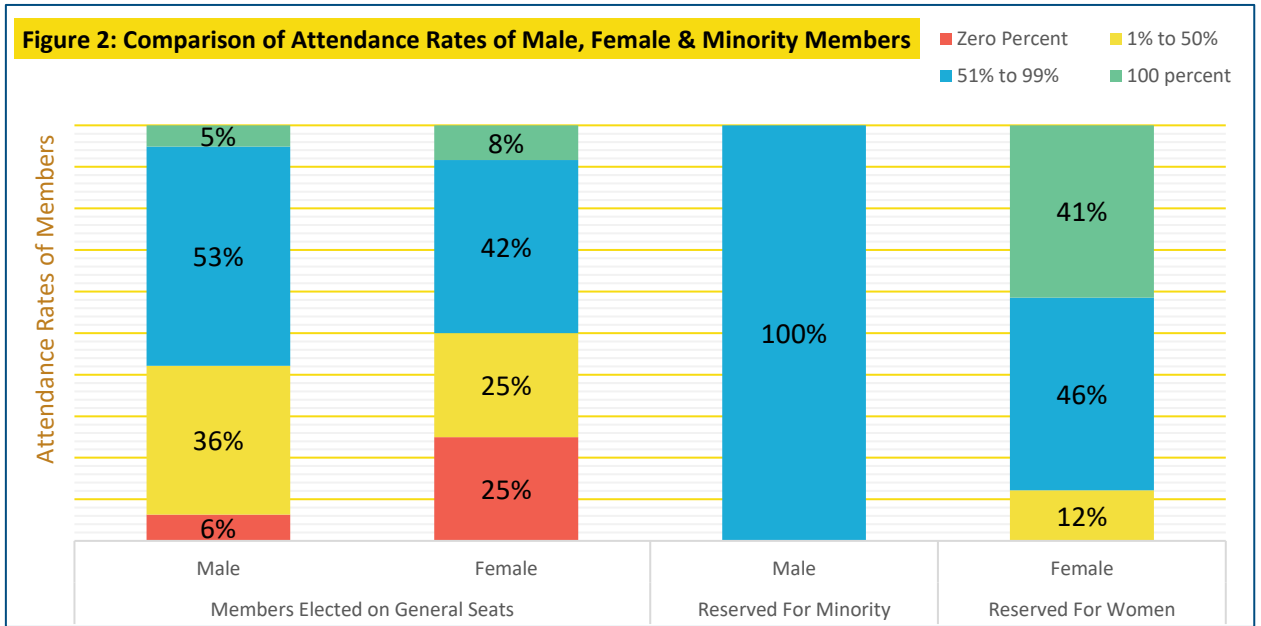
Figure 1: National Assembly Attendance, Disaggregated by the Number of Sittings Attended by Each MNA



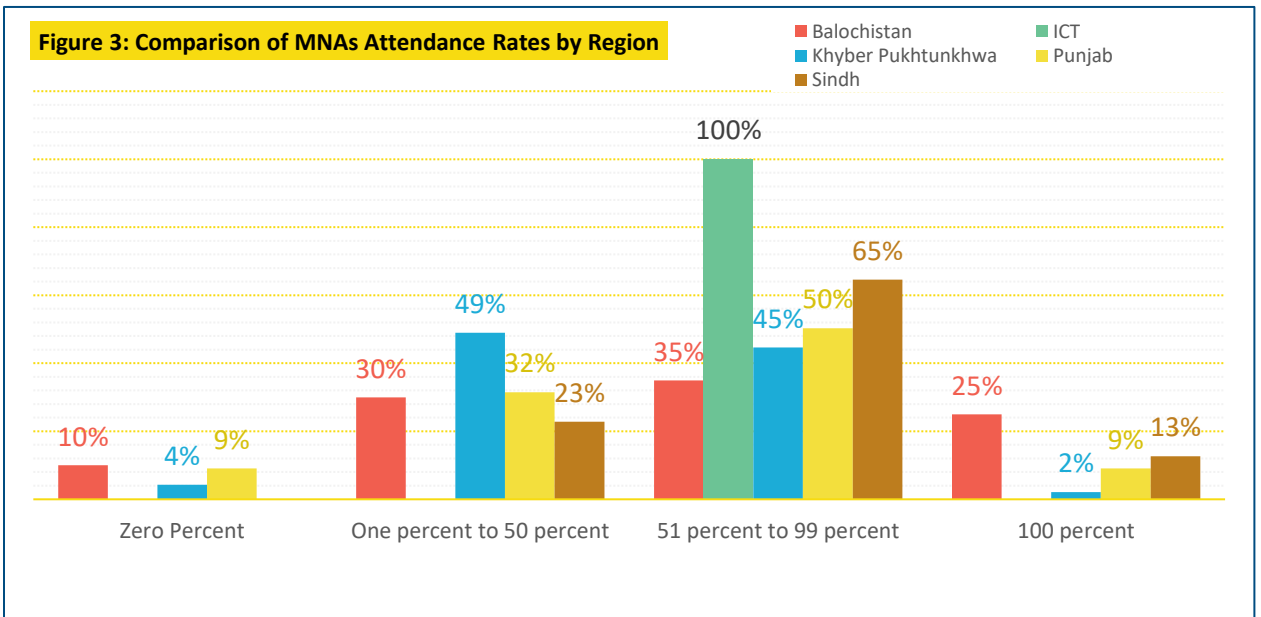
KEY HIGHLIGHTS

- The highest attendance was **239** members (**76** percent of the current membership) during the **fifth sitting**, coinciding with the passage of the 26th Constitutional Amendment.
- The lowest attendance was **122** members (**39** percent) during the **10th sitting**, on Private Members' Day.
- MNAs from **ICT and Sindh** were more regular than MNAs from other regions.
- As many as **289** members (**92** percent) skipped at least one sitting during the session.
- The House received leave applications for **124** members (**39** percent) during the session.
- As many as **159** members (**51** percent) skipped the House proceedings without any formal leave application.
- Minister of State for Finance and Revenue had the **highest attendance (77** percent) among all ministerial colleagues.
- Prime Minister attended **three (23** percent) and the Leader of the Opposition **10 (77** percent) sittings.

Members on seats reserved for women and religious minorities were generally more regular than members on the general seats. All seven members on the seats reserved for minorities and a minority member on general seat attended more than half of the sittings. Similarly, 36 (87 percent) female lawmakers elected on seats reserved for women attended more than 50 percent of the sittings. Among those elected on general seats, 59 percent male lawmakers and 50 percent female lawmakers attended more than half of the sittings during the session. More than a third (34 percent) of female lawmakers had a 100 percent attendance as compared to just five percent of male lawmakers in this category. Figure 2 shows a comparison between the attendance rates of disaggregated by seat type and gender.



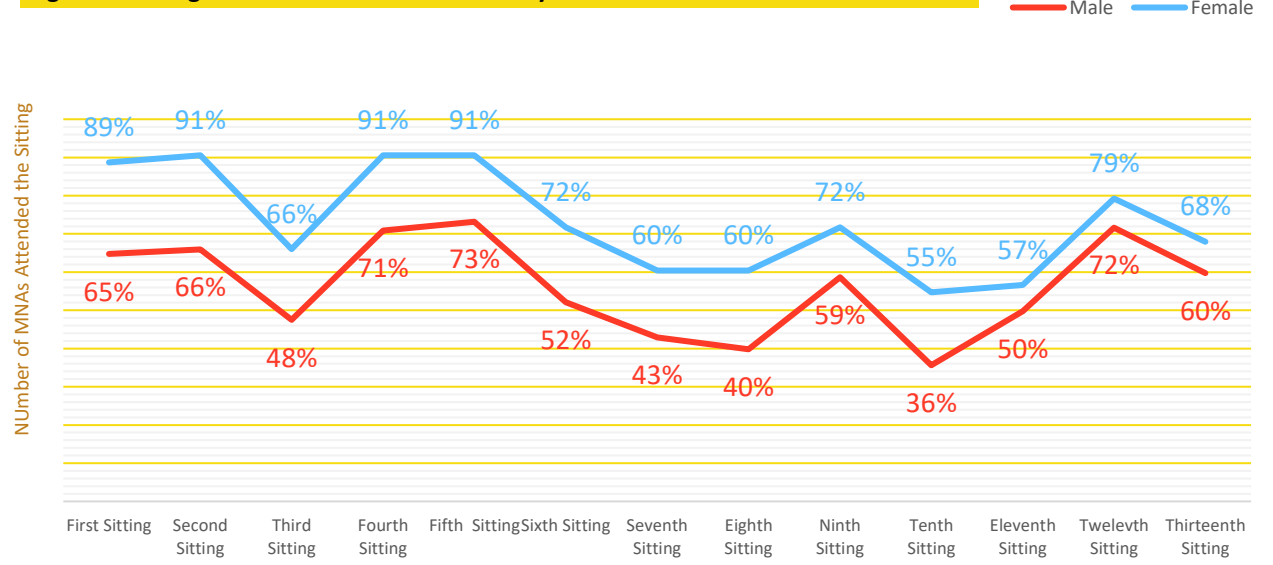
Regionally, MNAs from the Islamabad Capital Territory (ICT) and Sindh maintained higher attendance as compared to other regions. All three MNAs from ICT (100 percent) and 61 MNAs from Sindh (78 percent) attended more than half sittings during the reporting session. Balochistan and Punjab MNAs maintained a varying attendance pattern, with 60 percent and 59 percent of them attending more than half of the sittings. Interestingly, the highest percentage of MNAs in both the 100 percent attendance and zero attendance categories were of Balochistan. On the other hand, Punjab exhibited a more distributed attendance pattern across four categories. Khyber Pakhtunkhwa stood out as the only province where the majority of MNAs (25 or 51 percent) attended less than half of the sittings.

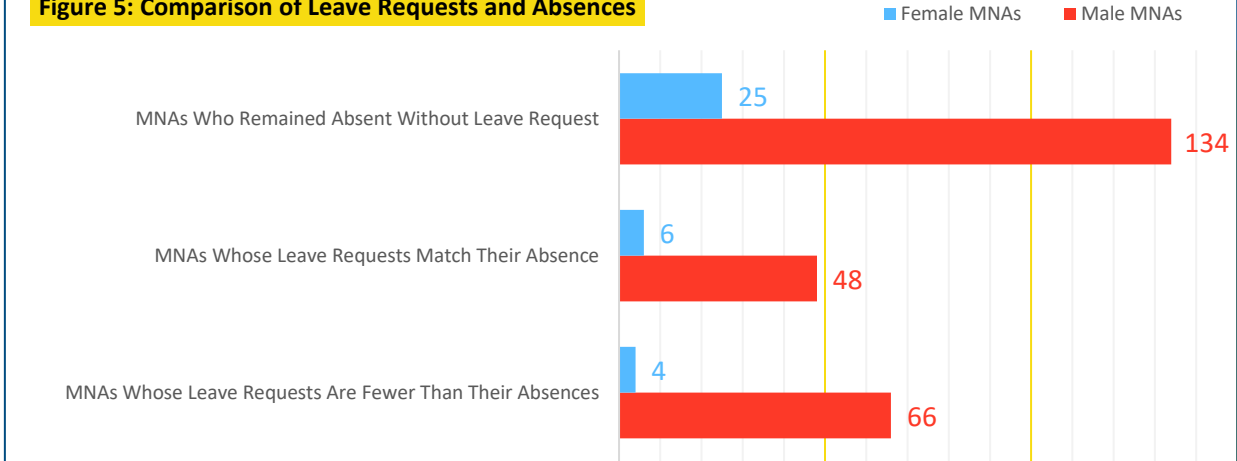
Figure 4: Sitting Wise Maximum Attendance By Male Members and Female Members

The attendance pattern fluctuated during the session with the highest attendance standing at 239 members (76 percent of the current membership) recorded during fifth sitting and the lowest attendance at 122 (39 percent) on 10th sitting. The peak attendance coincided with the passage of the 26th Constitutional Amendment, while the lowest attendance was recorded on Private Members' Day. Attendance increased during the 12th Sitting, which saw the passage of six government bills including the bills concerning judiciary. Figure 4 illustrates the gender-disaggregated attendance of the sittings, revealing that female attendance consistently higher than that of their male counterparts across all thirteen sittings.

159 MNAs skip sittings without any leave request

As many as 283 (90 percent of current strength) members skipped at least one sitting during the session. However, only 124 (44 percent) of them submitted an application to seek leave of the House for remaining absent. The remaining 159 (56 percent) skipped sitting(s) without any application. Even among those who did submit applications, only 54 (44 percent) sought leave for the entire duration of their absence while the rest 70 (56 percent) made themselves absent for longer duration than the number of days for which they sought leave.

Figure 5: Comparison of Leave Requests and Absences

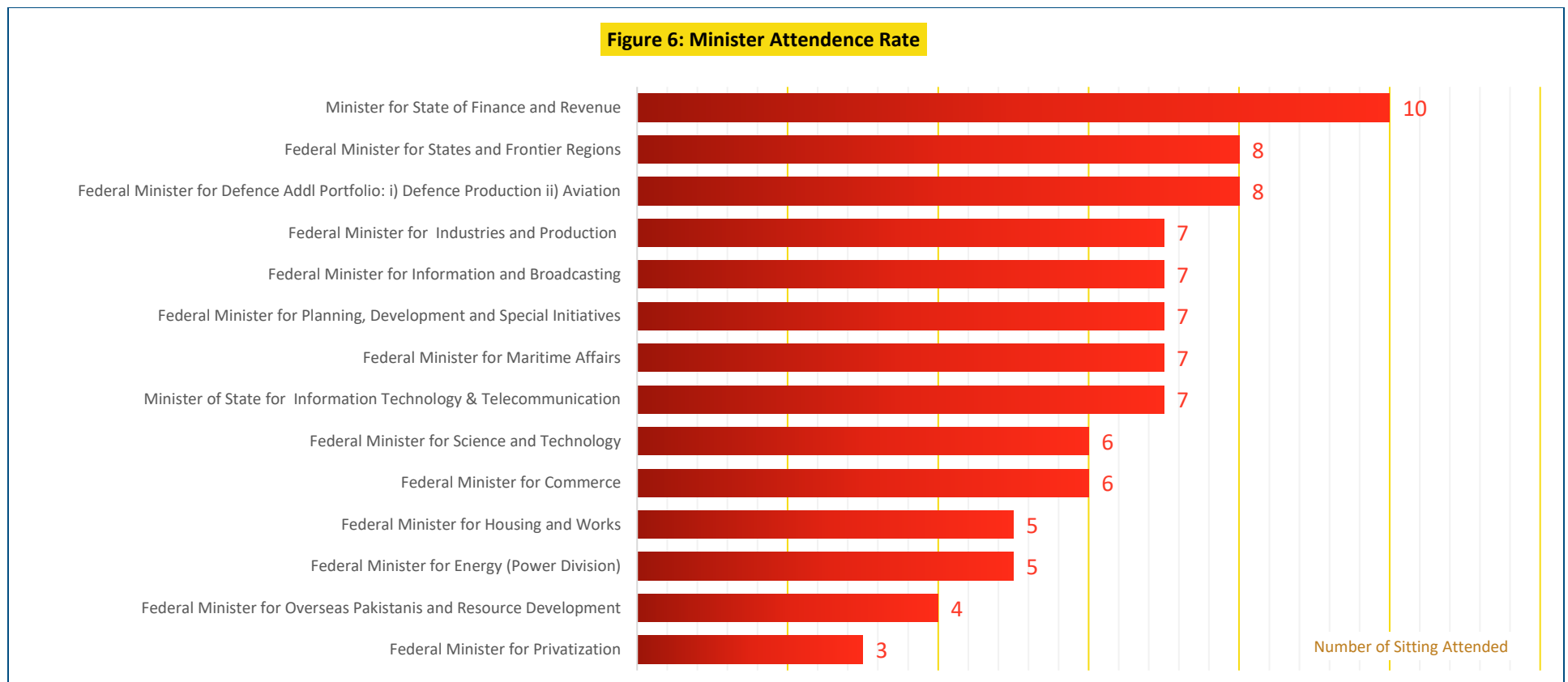


Eight out of 14 Ministers from the National Assembly attend more than half sittings

The incumbent cabinet comprises the Prime Minister and 18 Federal Ministers including 12 MNAs and six Senators. The cabinet members from the Senate are not ordinarily required to attend the Assembly’s session unless there’s an agenda item pertaining to their ministry. In addition to the federal ministers, as many as two MNAs hold the office of the Ministers of State and 30 of the Parliamentary Secretaries of various ministries.

The Minister of State for Finance and Revenue had the highest attendance (77 percent) among the ministers, followed by the Federal Minister for States and Frontier Regions (SAFRON) and Federal Minister for Defence. Following chart shows the number of sittings attended by each of the minister.

Major treasury parties maintain an above 50 percent attendance

The majority of lawmakers from PML-N and PPPP have attended over 50 percent of the sittings, while the majority of SIC members have attended fewer than 50 percent of the sittings. Additionally, lawmakers from smaller political parties have shown varying attendance rates. The sole lawmaker of BAP attended all sittings, while BNP lawmaker did not attend any sitting. Lawmakers from MWMP, NP, PKMAP, and PML-Z each attended more than 50 percent of the sittings. Following table shows the attendance rates, categorized by the parliamentary parties.

The Attendance Report Card of the Members of the National Assembly of Pakistan is an initiative by the Free and Fair Election Network (FAFEN) aimed at promoting transparency and accountability by making the performance of elected representatives accessible to the public. Their attendance serves as a key indicator of their commitment to legislative responsibilities, including representing their constituents, contributing to policy debates, and holding the government accountable.

This report presents a detailed analysis of MNAs' attendance during the plenary sittings of the National Assembly's 10th session, held from October 17 to November 8, 2024. It provides insights into attendance trends across regions, political parties, and gender, highlighting levels of engagement among lawmakers.

Since 2010, FAFEN has been systematically observing and reporting on the plenary proceedings of the federal Parliament and Provincial Assemblies. These efforts have significantly contributed to enhancing parliamentary transparency and strengthening the connection between citizens and their elected representatives, fostering a more inclusive and accountable democratic process.
