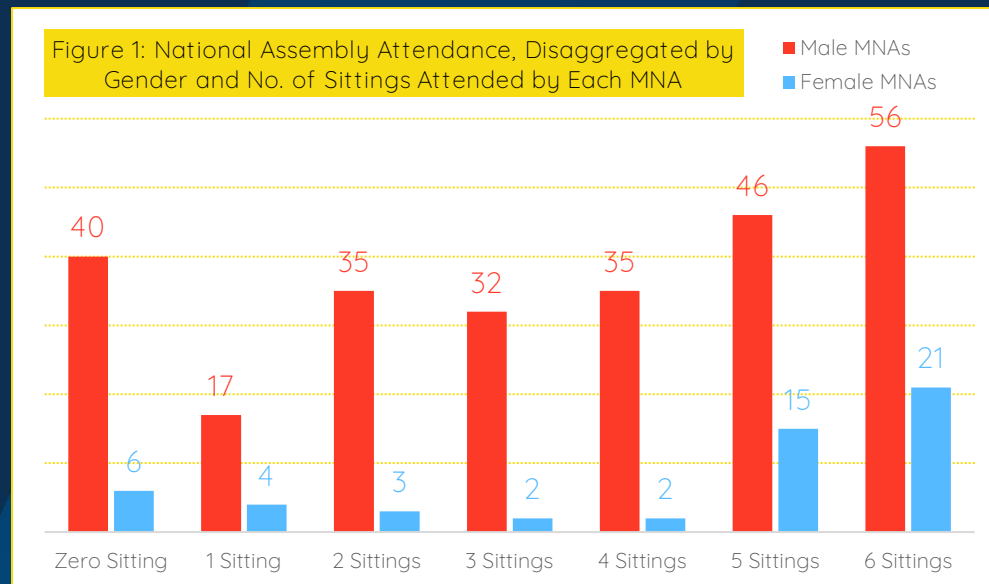

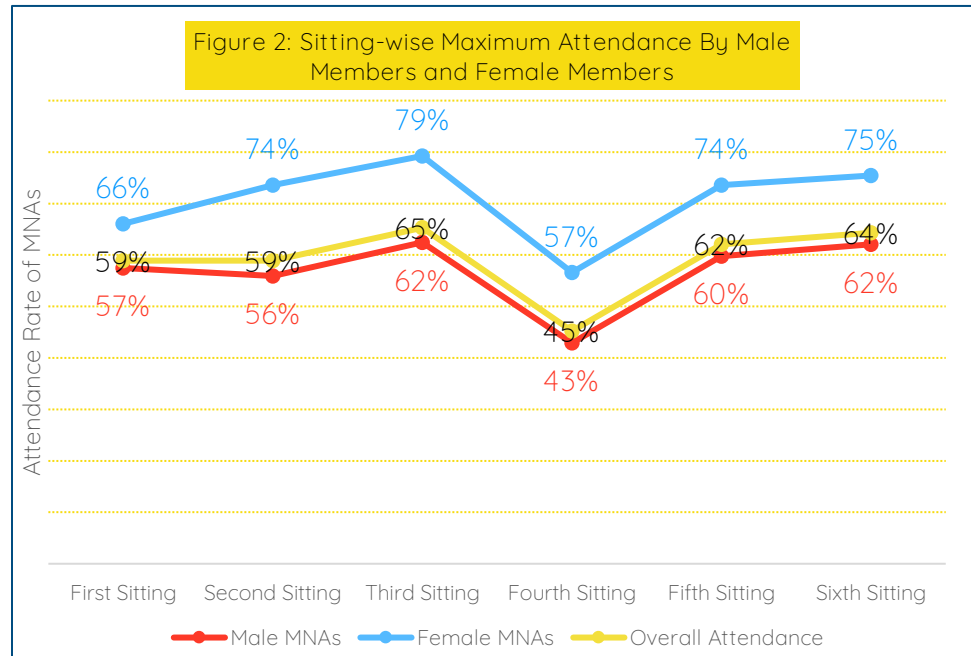
As many as 77 (25 percent) Members of the National Assembly (MNAs) attended all sittings, whereas 46 (15 percent) did not attend any sitting during the 13<sup>th</sup> session of the National Assembly that spanned over six sittings between February 10 and 18, 2025. Following chart shows the gender-disaggregated number of lawmakers grouped by the number of sittings they attended during the reporting session:



### KEY HIGHLIGHTS

- The third sitting had the highest number of MNAs (205 or 65 percent) present during the session.
- The fourth sitting had the lowest number of MNAs (142 or 45 percent) present.
- As many as 237 MNAs (75 percent) skipped at least one sitting during the session.
- As Many as 83 MNAs (35 percent) submitted applications for leave of absence during the session.
- As many as 154 MNAs (65 percent) skipped the House proceedings without any formal leave application in advance.
- Among the cabinet members, the Minister of State Finance & Revenue, and Power had the highest attendance, participating in five sittings.
- Prime Minister did not attend any sitting while the Leader of the Opposition attended three sittings (50 percent).

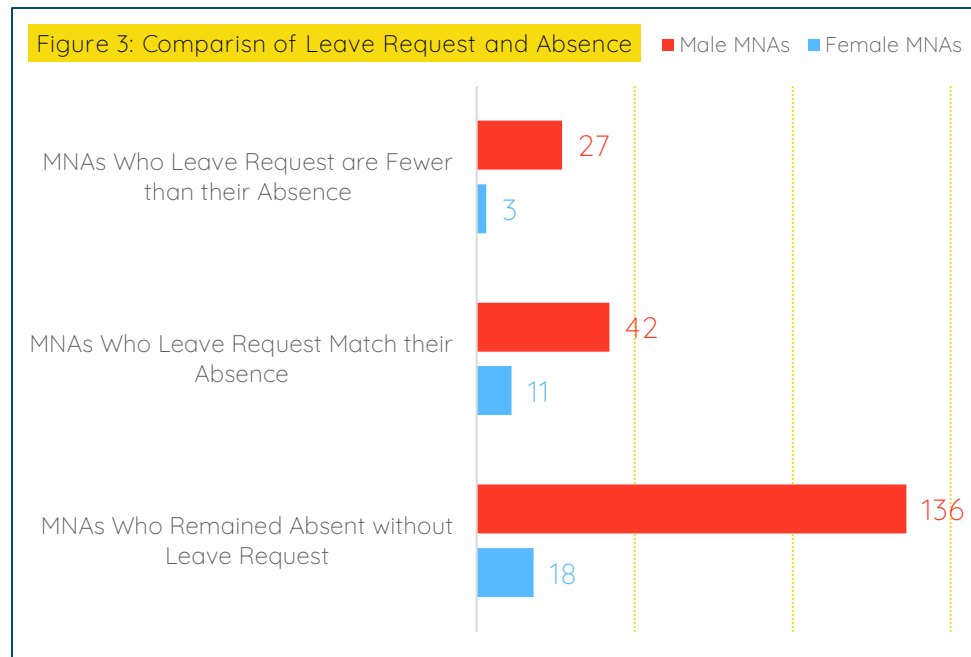
The attendance pattern fluctuated throughout the session, with female members consistently recording higher attendance than their male counterparts. The highest attendance was observed during the third sitting, with 205 members present, accounting for 65 percent of the total membership. During this sitting, the House passed the the resolution commemorating the National Women’s Day of Pakistan, that is observed on the February 12 each year. Conversely, the lowest attendance was recorded during the fourth sitting, with 142 (45 percent) members present. The sitting had to be adjourned after one hour and ten minutes due to lack of quorum pointed out by a lawmaker belonging to Sunni Ittehad Council (SIC).. Figure 2 illustrates the gender-disaggregated attendance in percentages across the sittings.



### 154 MNAs skip sittings without advance leave request

An analysis of the attendance and the leaves applications read during the proceedings shows that 237 members—75 percent of the current strength—missed at least one sitting during the current session. However, only 83 (35 percent) of these 237 submitted an application seeking leave from the House for their absence. Amongst these 83, 24 (29 percent) applied for leave in advance while 40 (48 percent) applied ex-post facto after returning from their leaves. Moreover, the leave applications of 19 (23 percent) MNAs were read on a day falling in the middle of their period of absence. The remaining 154 members (65 percent) skipped sittings without submitting any application during the session. Among those who did apply for leave, only 53 members (64 percent) sought approval for the entire duration of their absence, while the remaining 30 (36 percent) were absent for a longer period than the number of days for which they had requested leave. As many as five MNAs applied for leave of the House for staying absent during the previous session(s).

Seat-wise attendance records show varying trends. As many as 21 (40 percent) female MNAs – 17 on reserved and four on general seats – attended





all sittings, while 56 (21 percent) male MNAs – 53 on general seat and three on minorities’ seats – attended all sittings. On the other hand, five (12 percent) out of 41 female MNAs on reserved seats had zero attendance. four (ten percent) female MNAs attended less than half of the sittings, while 32 (78 percent) women on reserved seats attended more than half, including the 17 (41 percent) MNAs who attended all sittings. Six minority members attended more than half of the sittings including two lawmakers who attended all sittings while one has attended less than half of the sitting, Among male MNAs elected on general seats, 40 (16 percent) did not attend a single sitting, whereas 83 (33 percent) attended less than half of the sittings. In contrast, 131 (52 percent) lawmakers attended more than half of the sittings during the session, including the 53 (21 percent) MNAs who attended all sittings.. Figure 4 provides a comparison of attendance rates disaggregated by seat type and gender.

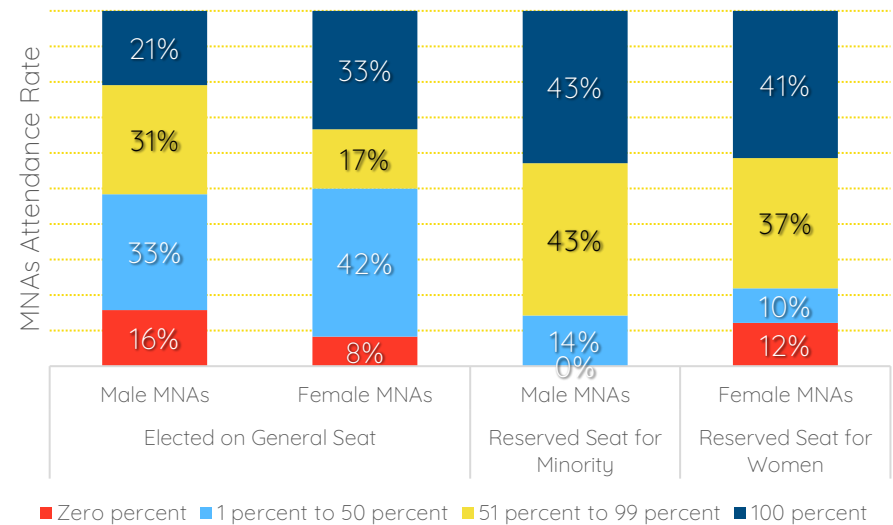
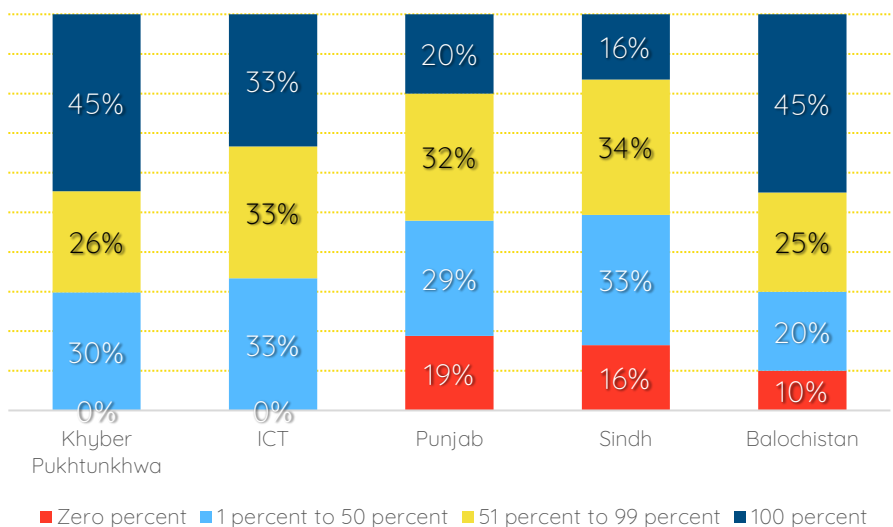
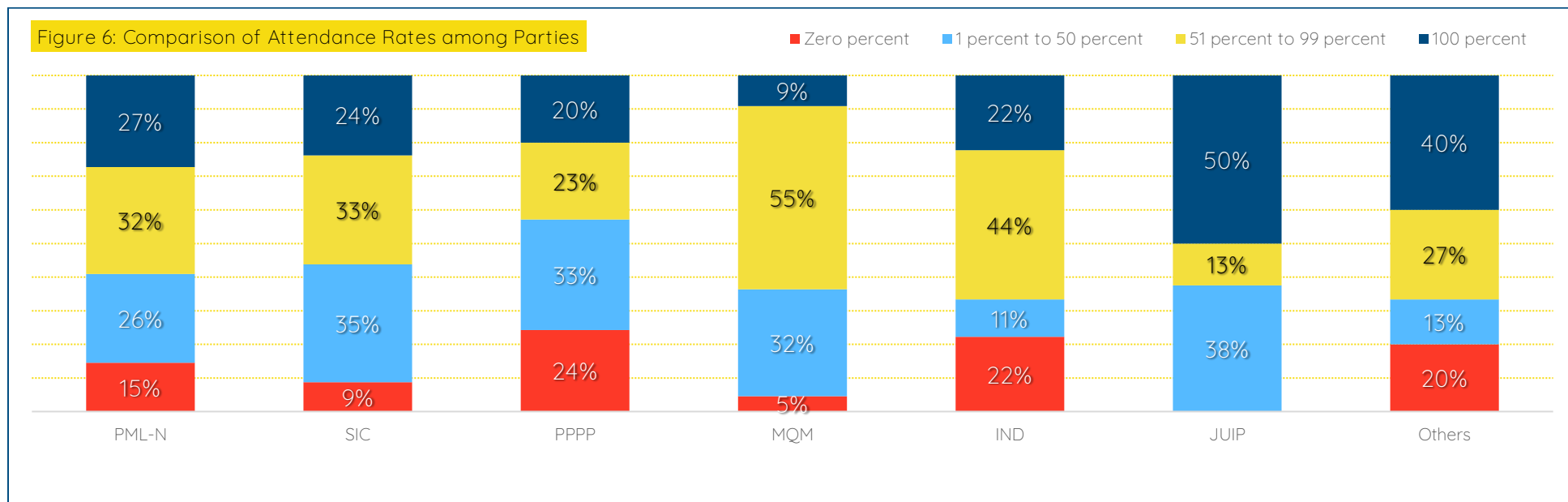


Figure 5: Comparison of Attendance Rates of Male, Female & Minority Members

Regionally, Balochistan and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa were the regions with highest percentage of MNAs attending the all sittings, followed by five (25 percent) lawmakers who have attended more than half of the sittings. Two (ten percent) lawmakers have not attended any sitting at all, whereas four (20 percent) have attended less than half of the sittings. From Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, 33 (70 percent) lawmakers attended more than half of the sittings, including 21 (45 percent) who have attended all sittings. As many as 14 (30 percent) lawmakers attended less than half of the sittings. In Punjab, 86 (52 percent) lawmakers have attended more than half of the sittings, including 33 (20 percent) MNAs who have attended all sittings. Thirty-one (19 percent) MNAs have not attended any sittings, whereas 48 (29 percent) have attended less than half of the sittings. From Sindh, 40 (51 percent) lawmakers have attended more than half of the sittings, including 13 (16 percent) MNAs who have attended all sittings. Twenty-six (33 percent) lawmakers have attended less than half of the sittings, whereas 13 (16 percent) MNAs have not attended any sitting. In ICT, one of the three lawmakers from the region attended all sittings, another attended more than half, while the third attended less than half of the sittings. Figure 5 provides a breakdown of attendance rates by region.

Figure 4: Comparison of Attendance Rates of Male, Female & Minority Members

## Political parties show varying attendance trends

The majority of lawmakers from Pakistan Muslim League-Nawaz (PML-N), Sunni Ittehad Council (SIC), Muthahida Qoumi Movement (MQM) and Jamiat Ulama-e-Islam Pakistan (JUIP) attended more than half of the sittings. The sole lawmaker from Balochistan Awami Party (BAP) has attended all sitting whereas the sloe lawmaker from Balochistan National Party (BNP) did not attend any sittings. Other parties with only one member, including from Balochistan Awami Party (BAP), National Party (NP), Majlis-e-Wahdat-ul-Muslimeen Pakistan (MWMP) and Pakistan Muslim League-Zia (PML-Z), each attended all sitting whereas sole lawmaker of Pakhtunkhwa Milli Awami Party (PKMAP) attended more than half of the sittings. Figure 6 shows the attendance rates categorized by parliamentary parties.



*The bar titled as "Others" cover all parties with fewer than eight MNAs including BAP, BNP, MWMP, NP, PKMAP, PML, PML-Z, IPP. BNP's sole lawmaker has announced submitting his resignation, which is yet to be officially accepted as the National Assembly website currently shows him as a member.*

## Lack of ministerial presence weakens legislative oversight

Among the 15 Federal Ministers whose presence was expected during the Question Hour to respond to questions related to their ministries, only six (40 percent) were marked present during the sittings where their presence was required, while seven (47 percent) did not attend such sittings. The remaining

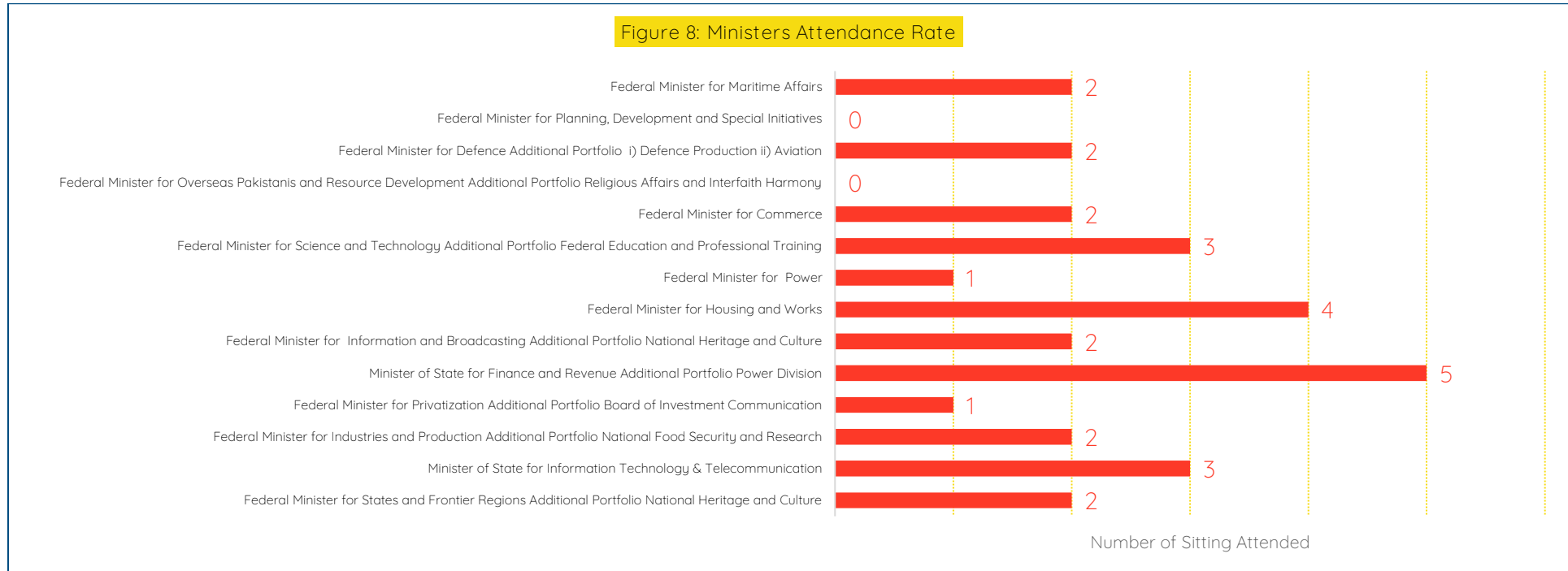


two (13 percent) ministers attended at least one of the sittings where they were expected. In their absence, another cabinet colleague or the relevant Parliamentary Secretary responded to questions on their behalf. The lawmakers highlighted the repeated absence of relevant ministers from multiple sittings. Concerns were raised over the ministers' failure to attend and respond to the business of the house, which was frequently postponed due to their absence. Members also suggested deferring questions, citing the parliamentary secretary's lack of understanding on the matters at hand, and proposed that the questions be postponed until the concerned minister was present.

The Minister of State for Finance and Revenue, who also holds an additional portfolio for the Power Division, had the highest attendance, participating in five sittings. This was followed by the Federal Minister for Housing and Works, who had a 67 percent attendance rate. The Minister of State for Information Technology & Telecommunication and the Federal Minister for Science and Technology, each, had a 50 percent attendance rate in the House. Figure 8 shows the number of sittings each cabinet minister belonging to the Lower House attended during the session according to official attendance records available on the National Assembly website.

The incumbent cabinet comprises the Prime Minister and 18 Federal Ministers including 12 MNAs and six Senators. The cabinet members from the Senate are not ordinarily required to attend the Assembly's session unless there's an agenda item pertaining to their ministry. In addition to the federal ministers, as many as two MNAs hold the office of the Ministers of State and 30 of the Parliamentary Secretaries of various ministries.

The Attendance Report Card of the Members of the National Assembly of Pakistan is an initiative by the Free and Fair Election Network (FAFEN) aimed at promoting transparency and accountability by making the performance of elected representatives accessible to the public. Their attendance serves as a key indicator of their commitment to legislative responsibilities, including representing their constituents, contributing to policy debates, and holding the government accountable.

This report presents a detailed analysis of MNAs' attendance during the plenary sittings of the National Assembly's 11th session, held from February 10 to February 18, 2025. It provides insights into attendance trends across regions, political parties, and gender, highlighting levels of engagement among lawmakers. The report relies on the verbatim debates for leave records of MNA.

Since 2010, FAFEN has been systematically observing and reporting on the plenary proceedings of the federal Parliament and Provincial Assemblies. These efforts have significantly contributed to enhancing parliamentary transparency and strengthening the connection between citizens and their elected representatives, fostering a more inclusive and accountable democratic process.
