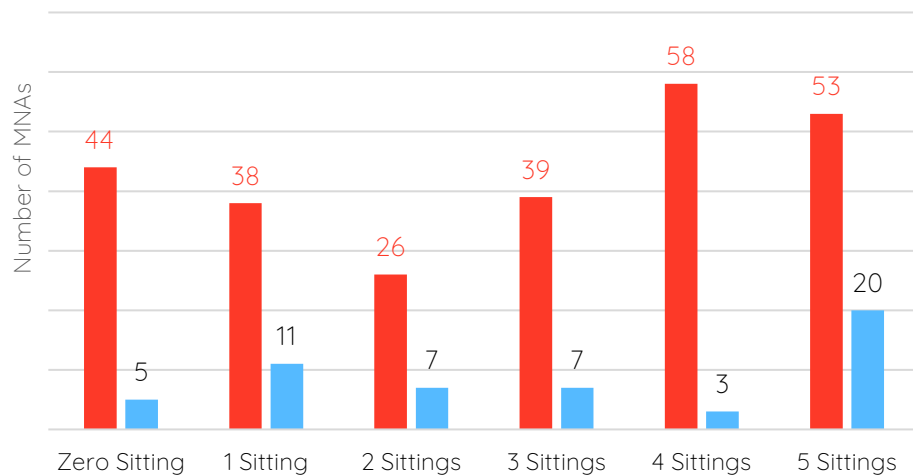

As many as 73 (23 percent) Members of the National Assembly (MNAs) attended all sittings, whereas 49 (16 percent) did not attend any sitting during the 15th session of the National Assembly that spanned over five sittings between April 7 and 14, 2025. Following chart shows the gender-disaggregated number of lawmakers grouped by the number of sittings they attended during the reporting session:

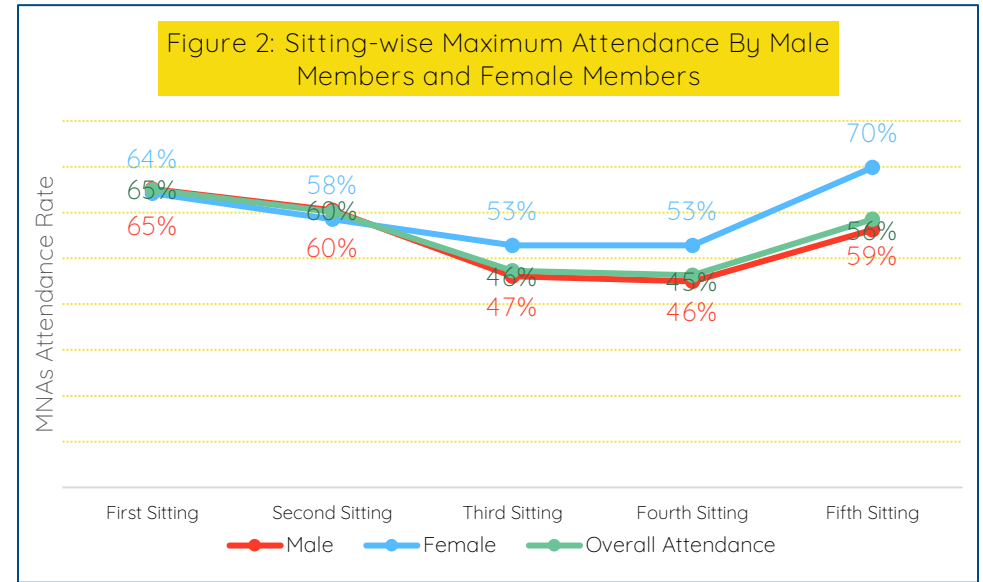
Figure 1: National Assembly Attendance, Disaggregated by Gender and No. of Sittings Attended by Each MNA



KEY HIGHLIGHTS

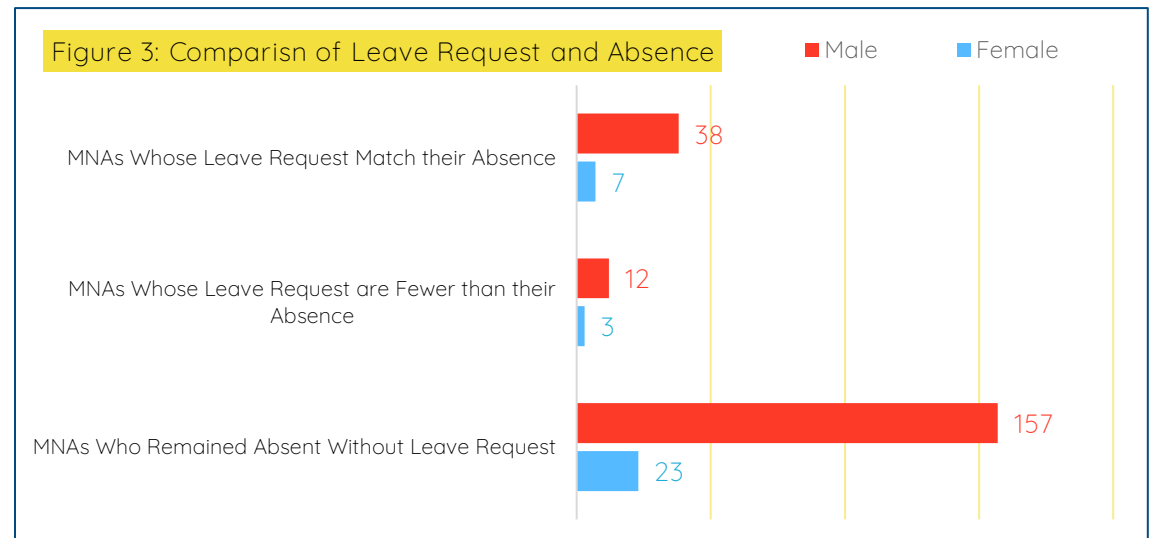
- The first sitting had the highest number of MNAs (202 or 65 percent of current membership) present during the session.
- The fourth sitting had the lowest number of MNAs (144 or 46 percent) present.
- As many as 240 (77 percent) MNAs skipped at least one sitting during the session.
- As Many as 60 (25 percent of 240) MNAs submitted applications for leave of absence during the session.
- As many as 180 (75 percent of 240) MNAs skipped the House proceedings without any formal leave application in advance.
- Among the cabinet members, four federal ministers and two state ministers attended all sittings.
- Prime Minister did not attend any sitting while the Leader of the Opposition attended three (60 percent) sittings.

Unlike previous sessions, gender-wise attendance patterns showed mixed trends during the reporting session. In the first and second sittings, male members had higher attendance than their female counterparts. However, in the third, fourth, and fifth sittings, female members' attendance surpassed that of male members. Overall, the attendance patterns indicated a declining trend as the session progressed. The highest attendance was recorded during the first sitting, with 202 members (65 percent of the current membership) present. Despite the strong attendance, most of the scheduled business remained unaddressed. Instead, the lawmakers discussed the issue of new canals on the Indus River through points of order. The lowest attendance was observed during the fourth sitting, with only 144 members (46 percent) present. The sitting was initially adjourned after just 13 minutes when a lawmaker from the Sunni Ittehad Council pointed out the lack of quorum, prompting a 30-minute suspension by the Speaker. Upon re-assembling, the quorum was still not met, leading the Deputy Speaker to adjourn the sitting. Figure 2 presents a gender-disaggregated attendance percentages in each sitting.



180 MNAs skip sittings without advance leave request

An analysis of the attendance and the leaves applications read during the proceedings shows that 240 members – 77 percent of the current strength – missed at least one sitting during the current session. However, only 60 (25 percent of these 240) submitted an application seeking leave from the House for their absence. Amongst these 60, 26 (43 percent of applicants) applied for leave in advance while 18 (30 percent of applicants) applied ex-post facto after returning from their leaves. The leave applications of the remaining 16 (27 percent) applicants were read on a day falling in the middle of their period of absence. As many as 45 members (75 percent of applicants) sought approval for the entire duration of their absence, while the remaining 15 (25 percent) were absent for a longer period than the number of days for which they had

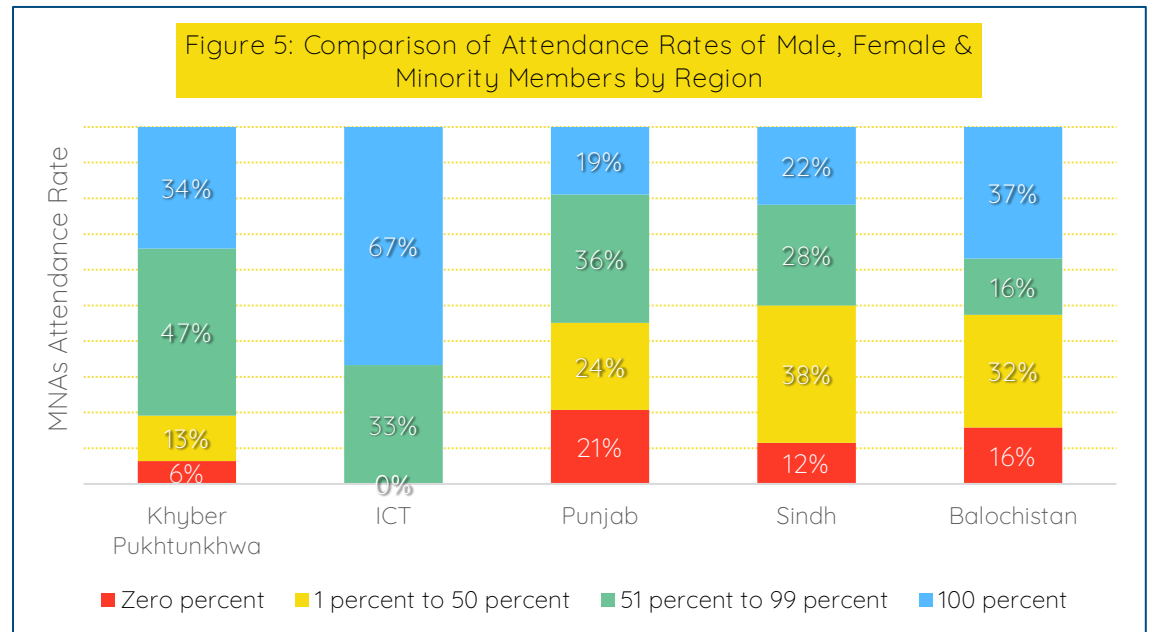
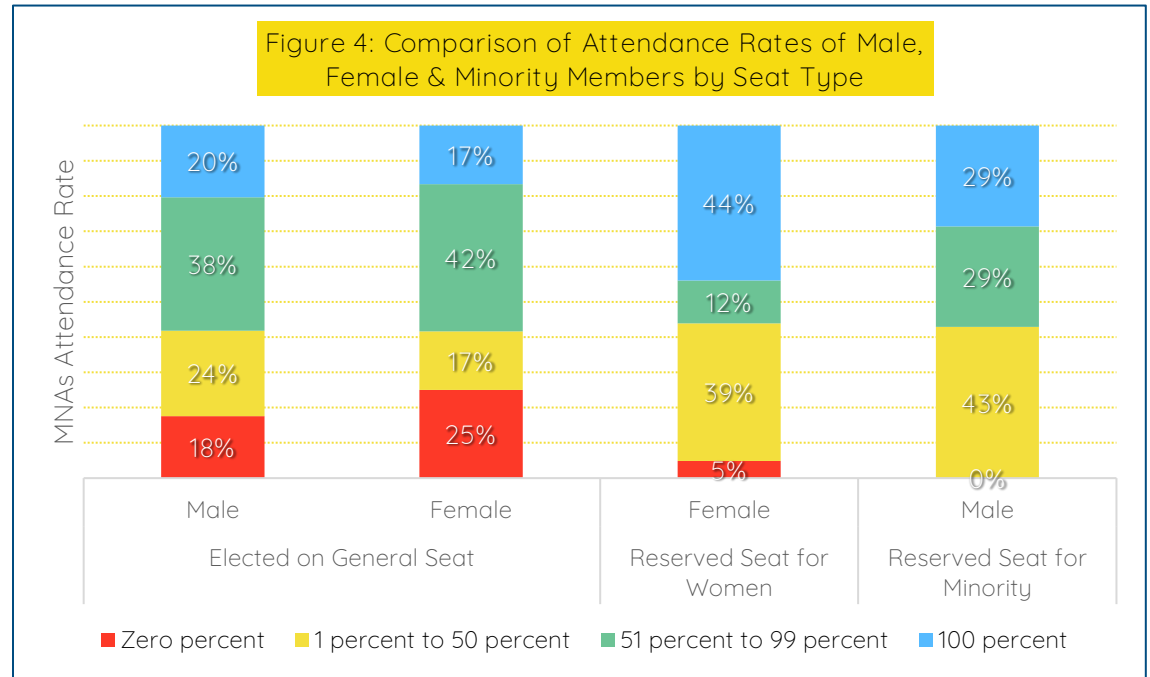




requested leave. As many as 180 members (75 percent of those skipping at least one sitting) remained absent without submitting any application during the session. As many as eight MNAs applied for leave of the House for staying absent during the previous session(s). Figure 3 presents a gender-wise comparative of leave request and absence.

A total of 20 female MNAs including 18 on reserved seats and two on general seats (38 percent of total female membership) attended all sittings. As many as five female MNAs (nine percent) – three on general seats and two on a reserved seat – recorded zero attendance. Among seven minority members, four attended more than half of the sittings including two who attended all sittings. As many as three members have attended less than half of the sittings. Among male MNAs elected on general seats, 44 (18 percent) did not attend any sitting, 61 (24 percent) were present in less than half of the sittings and 146 (58 percent) attended more than half of the sittings including 51 (20 percent) who were present during all sittings. Figure 4 presents a comparative analysis of attendance rates, disaggregated by seat type and gender.

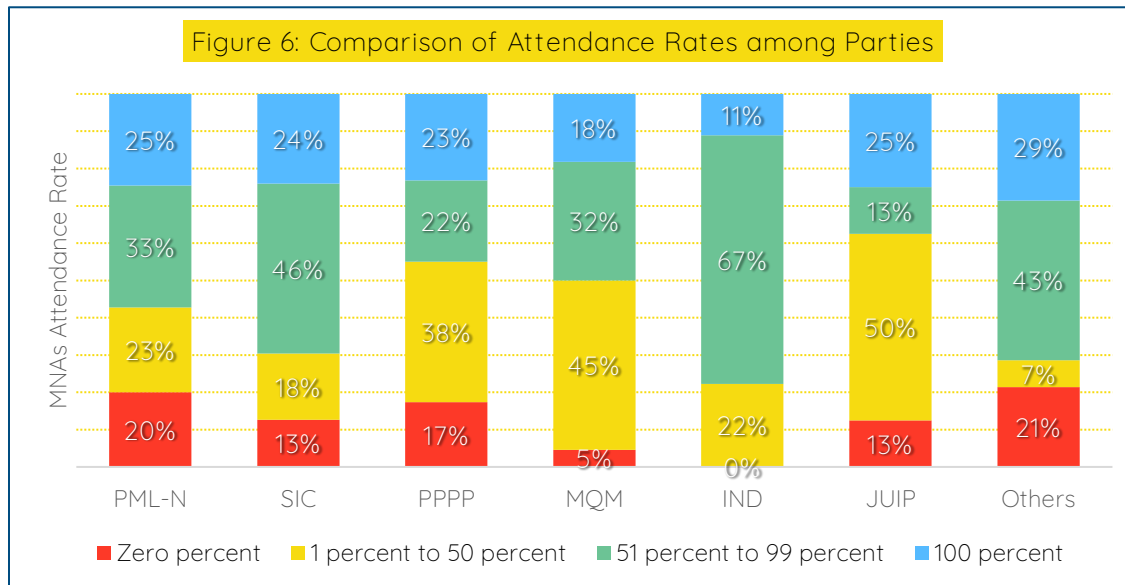
Regionally, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and Islamabad Capital Territory (ICT) recorded the highest percentage of MNAs attending more than half of the sittings. In total, all three (100 percent) MNAs from ICT, 38 (81 percent) from Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, 10 (53 percent) from Balochistan, 90 (55 percent) from Punjab and 39 (50 percent) from Sindh attended more than half of the sittings. However, three lawmakers from Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (six percent), 34 (21 percent) from Punjab, nine (12 percent) from Sindh, and three (16 percent) from Balochistan did not attend any sittings. Figure 5 provides a detailed breakdown of attendance rates by region.



Political parties show varying attendance trends

The majority of independent lawmakers, and those belonging to Sunni Ittehad Council (SIC) and Pakistan Muslim League-Nawaz (PML-N) attended more than half of the sittings. Smaller parliamentary parties with only one member, including Majlis-e-Wahdat-ul-Muslimeen Pakistan (MWMP), Pakhtunkhwa Milli Awami Party (PKMAP), Balochistan Awami Party (BAP) attended all sittings. The sole lawmaker from the National Party (NP) and Pakistan Muslim League-Zia (PML-Z) each attended more than half of the sittings. Figure 6 shows the attendance rates categorized by parliamentary parties.

The bar titled as "Others" cover all parties with fewer than eight MNAs including BAP, MWMP, NP, PKMAP, PML, PML-Z, IPP. BNP's sole lawmaker has announced submitting his resignation, which is yet to be officially accepted as the National Assembly website currently shows him as a member.



Lack of ministerial presence weakens legislative oversight

Among the 29 Federal Ministers who were expected to be present during the Question Hour to respond to queries related to their ministries, only 12 (41 percent) were marked present during the sittings where their presence was required. As many as 17 ministers (59 percent) did not attend any of the sittings when their presence was required. In their absence, another cabinet colleague or relevant Parliamentary Secretary responded to the questions on their behalf.

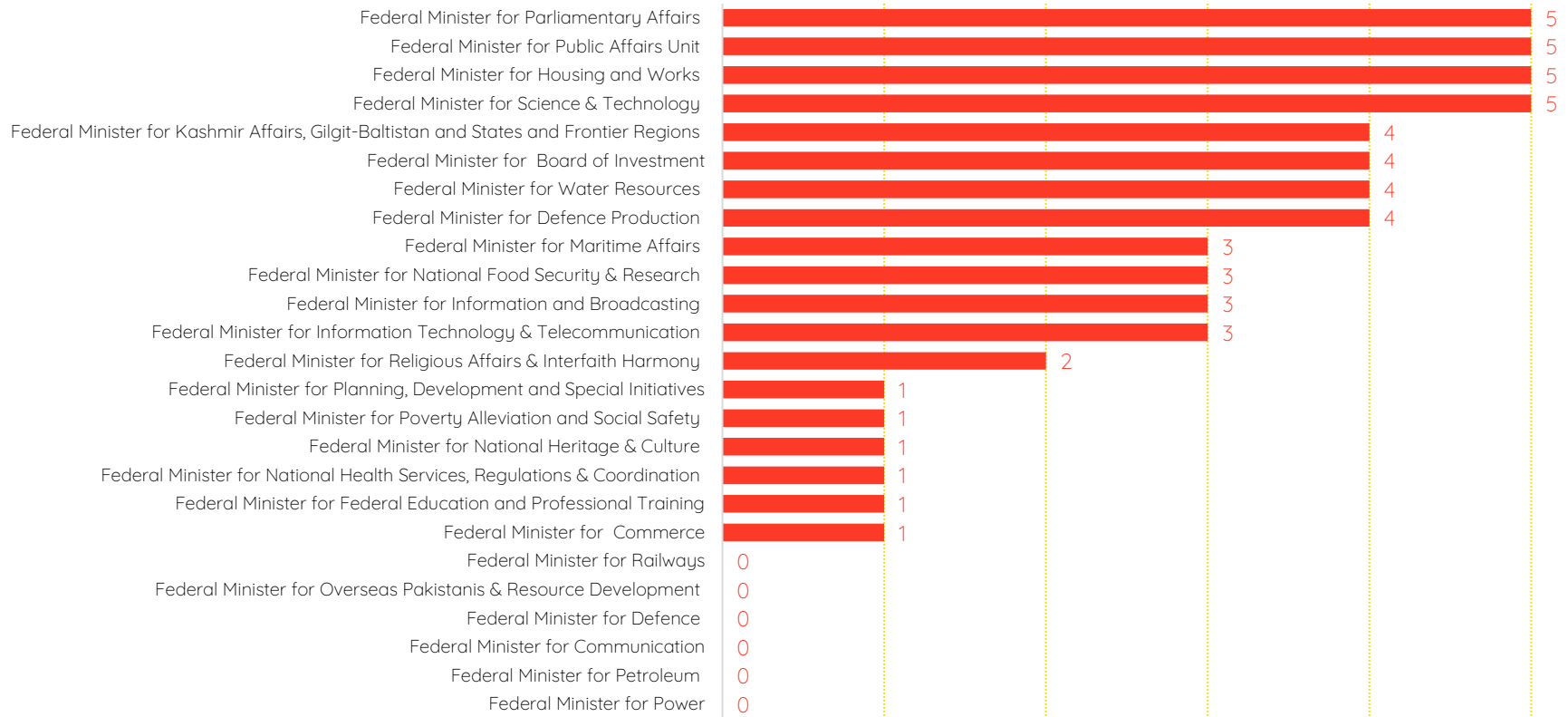
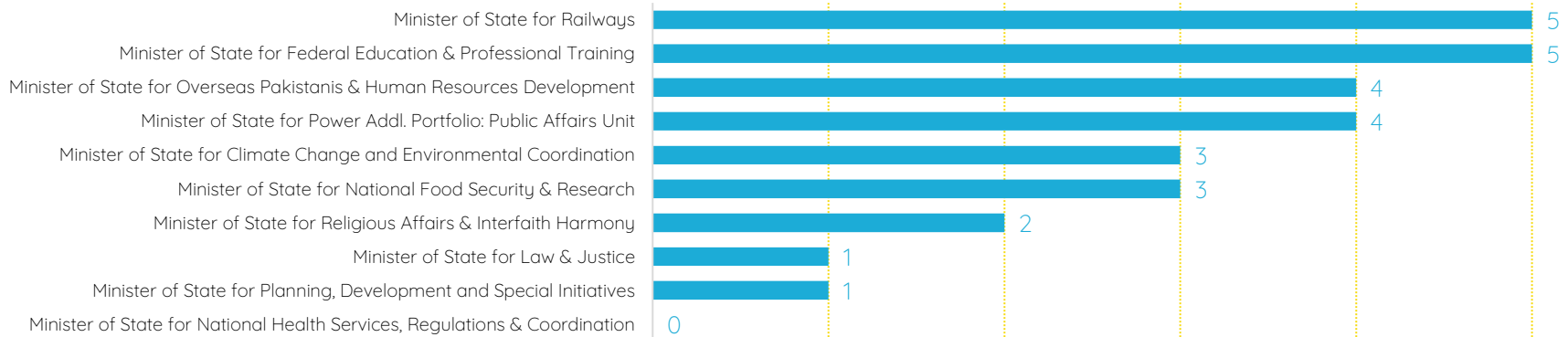


Figure 8: Attendance of State Ministers

The Federal Ministers for Parliamentary Affairs, Public Affairs Unit, Housing and Works, and Science and Technology attended all sittings. Similarly, the Ministers of State for Railways, Federal Education and Professional Training also attended all sittings. Figures 7 and 8 illustrate the number of sittings each cabinet minister from the Lower House attended during the session, based on official attendance records available on the National Assembly website.

The incumbent cabinet comprises the Prime Minister and 31 Federal Ministers including 25 MNAs and six Senators. The cabinet members from the Senate are not ordinarily required to attend the Assembly's session unless there's an agenda item pertaining to their ministry. In addition to the federal ministers, as many as 11 MNAs hold the office of the Ministers of State and 24 of the Parliamentary Secretaries of various ministries.



Figure 7: Attendance of Federal Ministers

The Attendance Report Card of the Members of the National Assembly of Pakistan is an initiative by the Free and Fair Election Network (FAFEN) aimed at promoting transparency and accountability by making the performance of elected representatives accessible to the public. Their attendance serves as a key indicator of their commitment to legislative responsibilities, including representing their constituents, contributing to policy debates, and holding the government accountable.

This report presents a detailed analysis of MNAs' attendance during the plenary sittings of the National Assembly's 15th session, held from April 7 to April 14, 2025. It provides insights into attendance trends across regions, political parties, and gender, highlighting levels of engagement among lawmakers. The report relies on the verbatim debates for leave records of MNA.

Since 2010, FAFEN has been systematically observing and reporting on the plenary proceedings of the federal Parliament and Provincial Assemblies. These efforts have significantly contributed to enhancing parliamentary transparency and strengthening the connection between citizens and their elected representatives, fostering a more inclusive and accountable democratic process.
