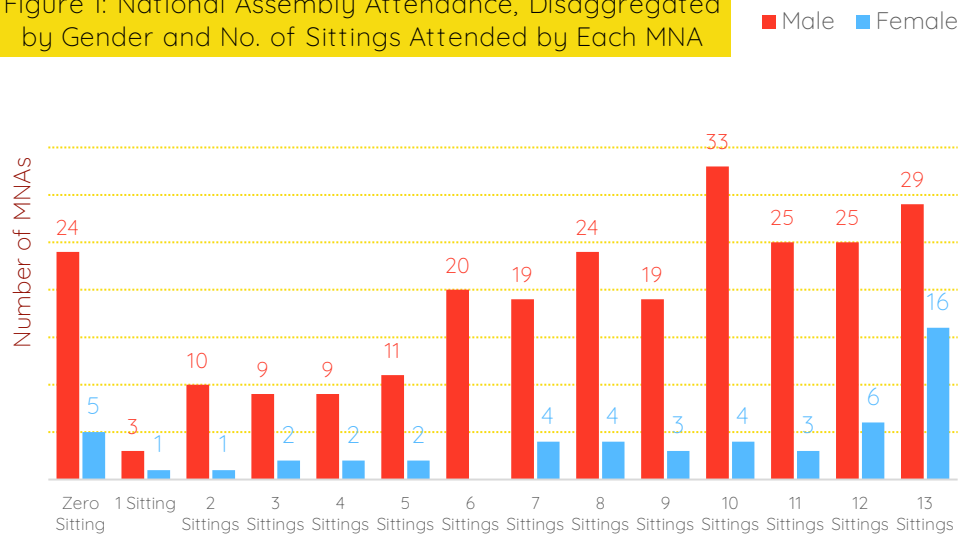

As many as 45 (14 percent) Members of the National Assembly (MNAs) attended all sittings, whereas 29 (nine percent) did not attend any sitting during the 16th session of the National Assembly that spanned over 13 sittings between May 5 and 22, 2025. Following chart shows the gender-disaggregated number of lawmakers grouped by the number of sittings they attended during the reporting session:

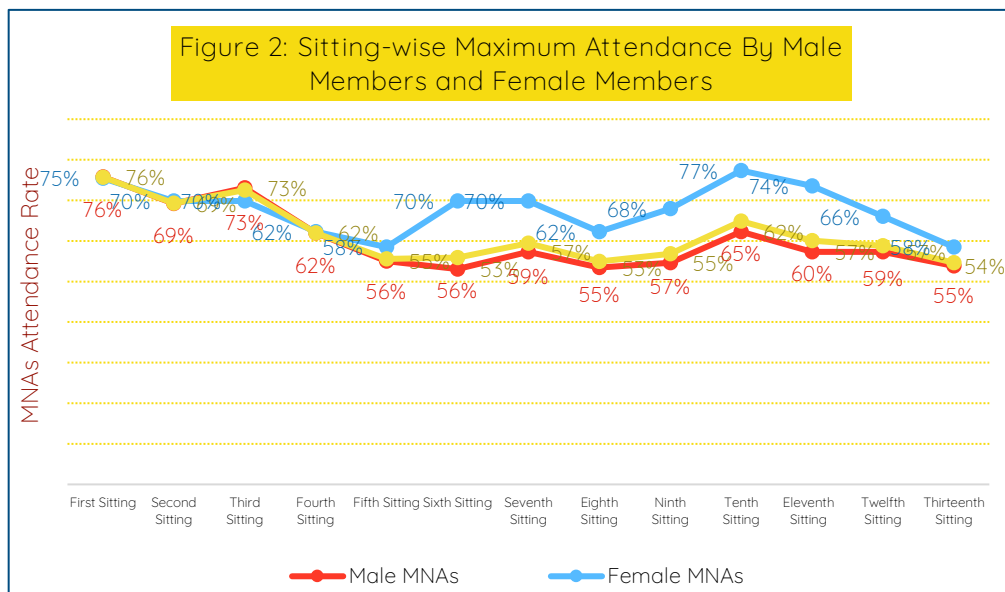
Figure 1: National Assembly Attendance, Disaggregated by Gender and No. of Sittings Attended by Each MNA



KEY HIGHLIGHTS

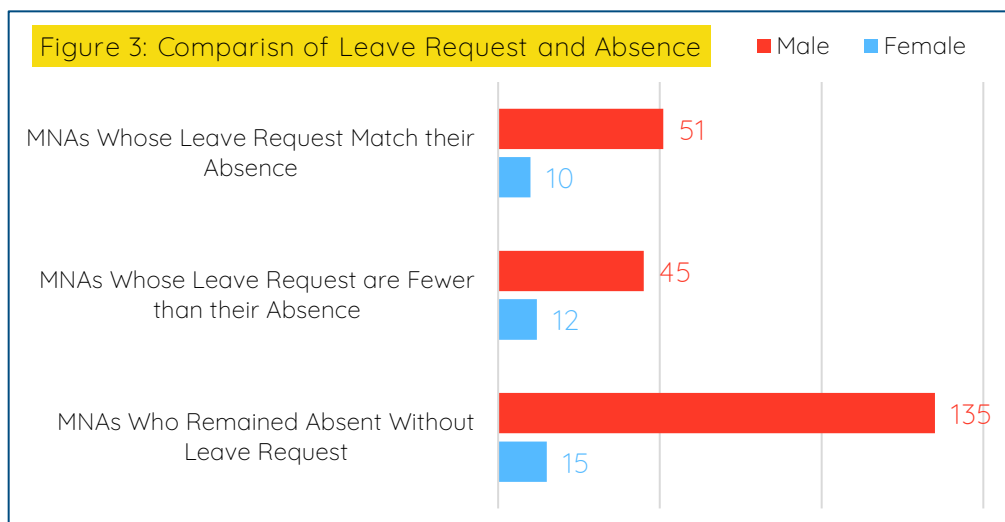
- The first sitting had the highest number of MNAs (237 or 76 percent of current membership) present during the session.
- The last sitting had the lowest number of MNAs (174 or 55 percent) present.
- As many as 268 (86 percent) MNAs skipped at least one sitting during the session.
- As Many as 118 (44 percent of 268) MNAs submitted applications for leave of absence during the session.
- As many as 150 (56 percent of 268) MNAs skipped the House proceedings without any formal leave application in advance.
- Among the cabinet members, four federal ministers attended all sittings, while three state ministers had the highest attendance among their group, attending 10 out of 13 sittings.
- Prime Minister attended one sitting while the Leader of the Opposition attended two (15 percent) sittings.

Consistent with the previous sessions, female attendance was generally higher than that of their male counterparts during the reporting session. The highest attendance was recorded during the first sitting, with 237 members (76 percent of the current membership) present. During this sitting, the House suspended its regular agenda by adopting a motion to this effect under Rule 288 to discuss the recent Pakistan-India conflict. The lowest attendance was observed during the last sitting, with only 174 members (55 percent) present. This sitting was initially adjourned after just 13 minutes when a lawmaker from the Sunni Ittehad Council pointed out the lack of quorum. This prompted the Speaker to suspend the proceedings for 15 minutes. The House later reconvened and, during the resumed session, passed The Off the Grid (Captive Power Plants) Levy Bill, 2025. The bill was not included on the regular Orders of the Day. Lawmakers raised concerns on the passage of bill by disregarding the complete legislative procedure. Minor discrepancies between the daily bulletin and official attendance records were noted in at least two sittings. During the 5th sitting, the daily bulletin reported 175 members present, whereas the official attendance showed 174. Similarly, for the 13th sitting, the bulletin indicated 170 members in attendance, while the official record listed 171.



150 MNAs skip sittings without advance leave

An analysis of the attendance and the leaves applications read during the proceedings shows that 268 members — 86 percent of the current strength — missed at least one sitting during the current session. However, only 118 (44 percent of these 268) submitted an application seeking leave from the House for their absence. Amongst these 118, 25 (21 percent of applicants) applied for leave in advance while 37 (31 percent of applicants) applied ex-post facto after returning from their leaves. The leave applications of the remaining 56 (47 percent) applicants were read on a day falling in the middle of their period of absence. As many as 65 members (52 percent of applicants) sought approval for the entire duration of their absence, while the remaining 57 (48 percent) were absent for a longer period than the number of days for which they had requested leave. As many as 150 members (56 percent





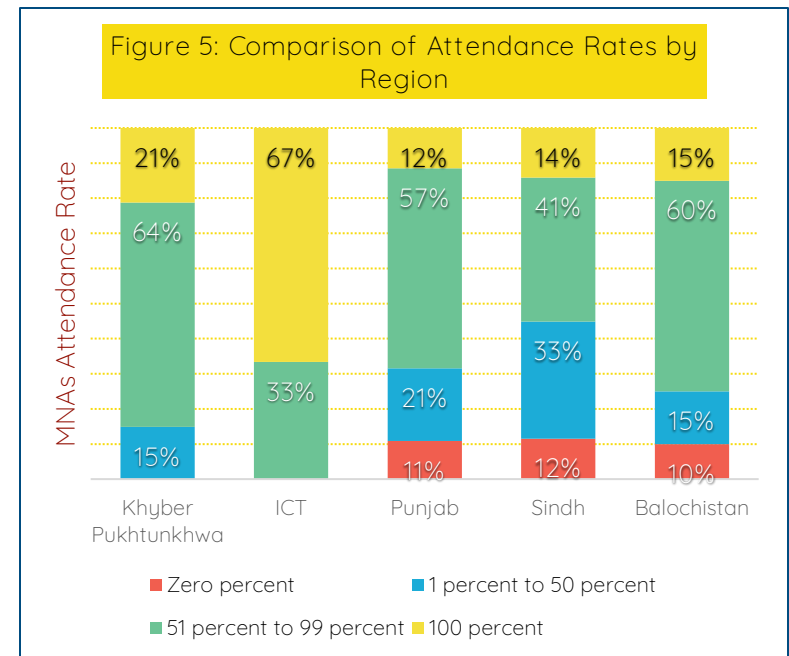
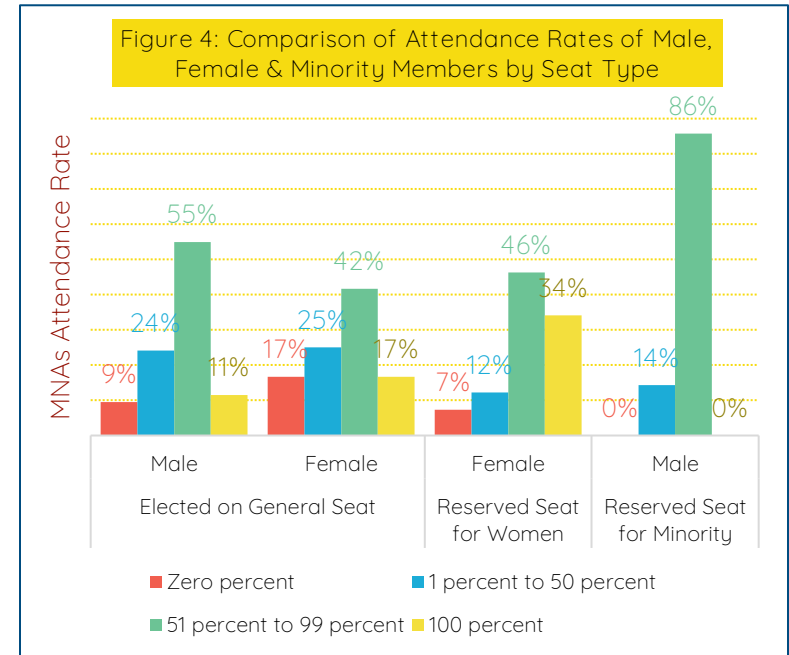
of those skipping at least one sitting) remained absent without submitting any application during the session. Additionally, as many as 23 MNAs applied for leave of the House for staying absent during the previous session(s). Figure 3 presents a gender-wise comparative of leave request and absence.

A total of 16 female MNAs including 14 on reserved seats and two on general seats (30 percent of total female membership) attended all sittings. As many as five female MNAs (nine percent) – three on general seats and two on a reserved seat – recorded zero attendance. Among seven minority members, six attended more than half of the sittings whereas one has attended less than half of the sittings. Among male MNAs elected on general seats, 24 (nine percent) did not attend any sitting, 61 (24 percent) were present in less than half of the sittings and 168 (65 percent) attended more than half of the sittings including 29 (11 percent) who were present during all sittings. Figure 4 presents a comparative analysis of attendance rates, disaggregated by seat type and gender.

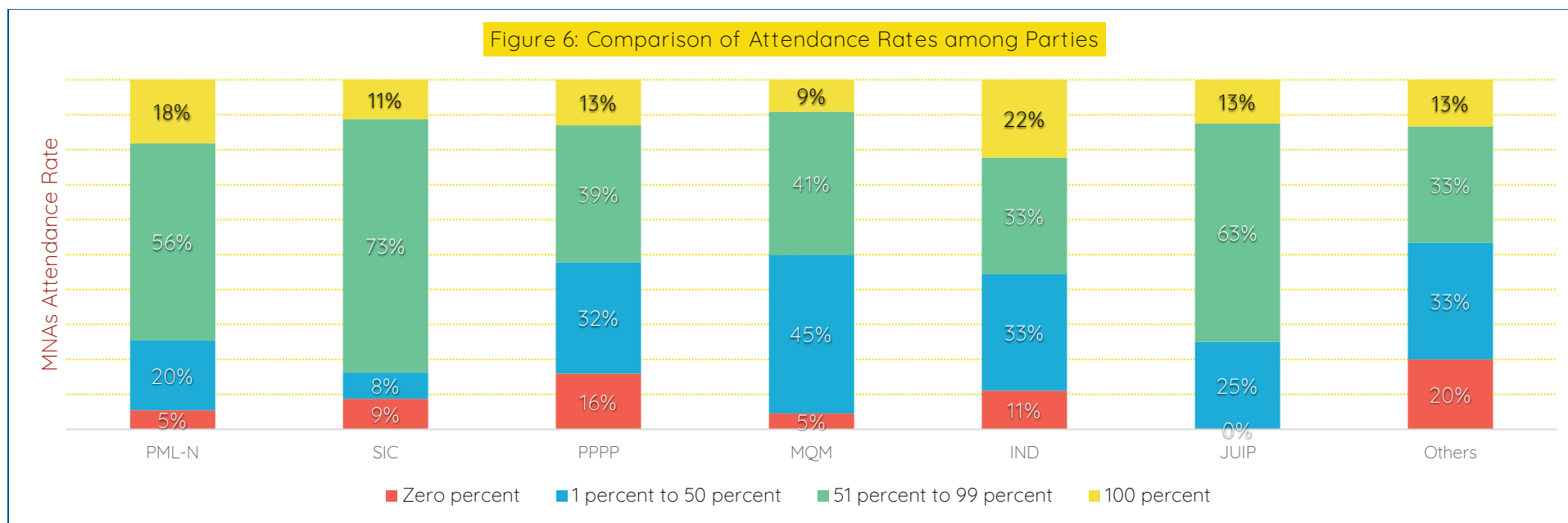
Regionally, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and Islamabad Capital Territory (ICT) recorded the highest percentage of MNAs attending more than half of the sittings. All three MNAs have attended more than half of the sitting including two MNAs who have attended all sittings. 40 (85 percent) from Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, 15 (75 percent) from Balochistan, 113 (68 percent) from Punjab and 43 (55 percent) from Sindh attended more than half of the sittings. However, 18 lawmakers from Punjab (11 percent) from Punjab, nine (12 percent) from Sindh, and two (10 percent) from Balochistan did not attend any sittings. Figure 5 provides a detailed breakdown of attendance rates by region.

Political parties show varying attendance trends

The majority of lawmakers from the Sunni Ittehad Council (SIC), Pakistan Muslim League-Nawaz (PML-N), Jamiat Ulema-e-Islam Pakistan (JUIP), and independent members attended more than half of the sittings. Single-member parliamentary parties including the Majlis-e-Wahdat-ul-Muslimeen Pakistan (MWMP) and the Balochistan Awami Party (BAP), had full attendance in all sitting. Lawmakers from the Pakhtunkhwa Milli Awami Party (PKMAP) and the National Party (NP) each attended more than half of the sittings. However, the sole representatives of the Awami National Party (ANP) and Pakistan Muslim League-Zia



(PML-Z) attended less than half of the sittings. Figure 6 shows the attendance rates categorized by parliamentary parties.



The bar titled as "Others" cover all parties with fewer than eight MNAs including BAP, MWMP, NP, PKMAP, PML, PML-Z, IPP..BNP's sole lawmaker has announced submitting his resignation, which is yet to be officially accepted as the National Assembly website currently shows him as a member.

Lack of ministerial presence weakens legislative oversight

Among the 29 Federal Ministers who were expected to be present during the Question Hour to respond to queries related to their ministries, only 15 (52 percent) were marked present during the sittings where their presence was required. As many as 14 ministers (48 percent) did not attend any of the sittings when their presence was required. In their absence, another cabinet colleague or relevant Parliamentary Secretary responded to the questions on their behalf.

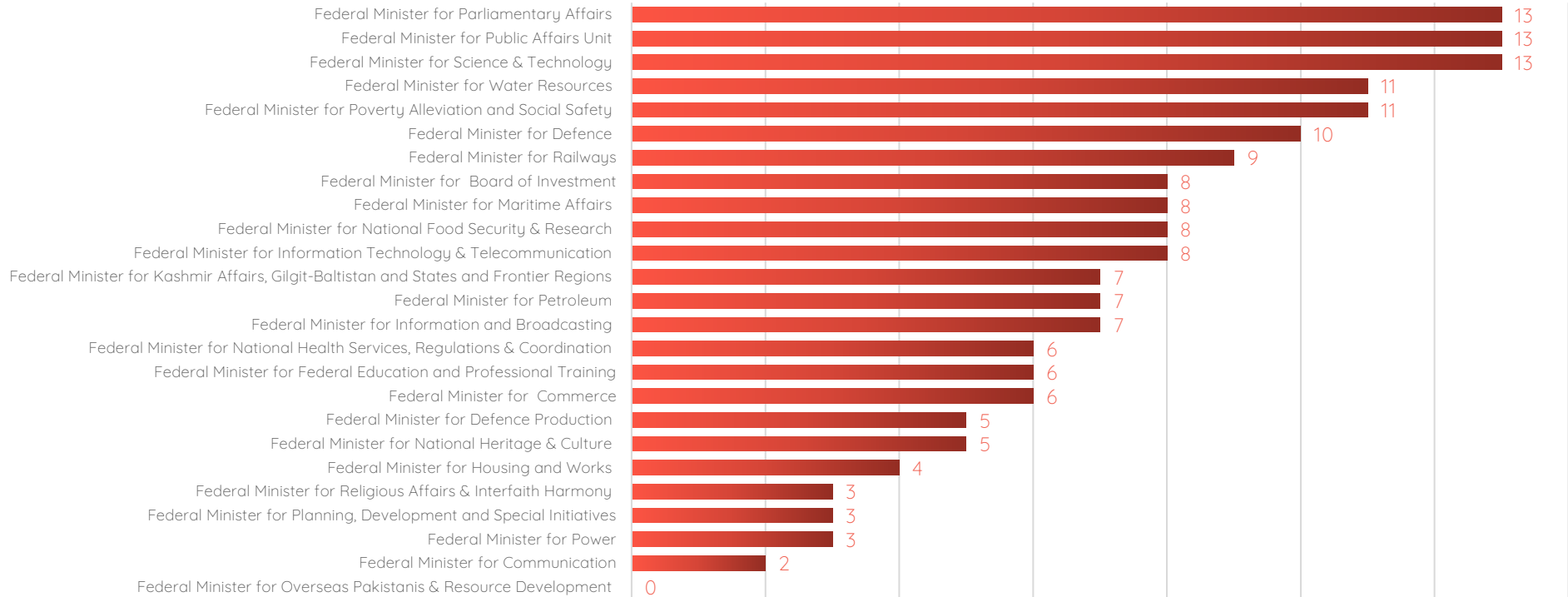
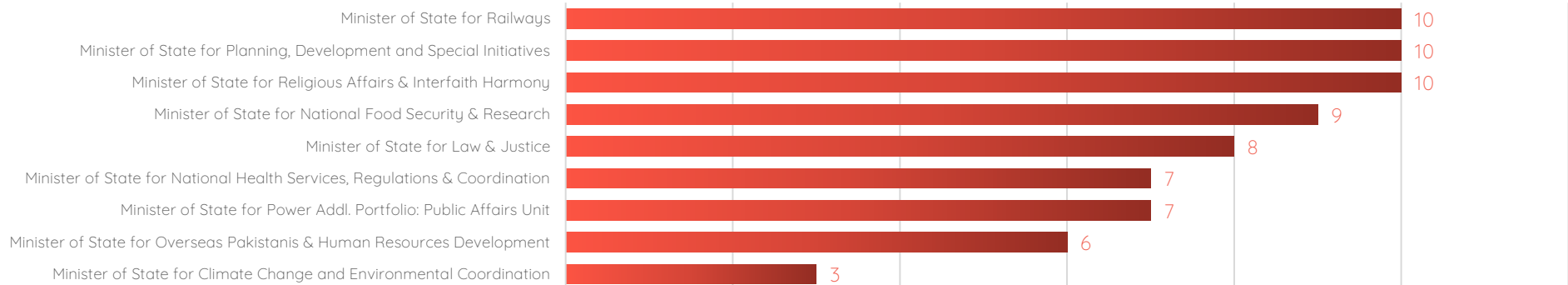
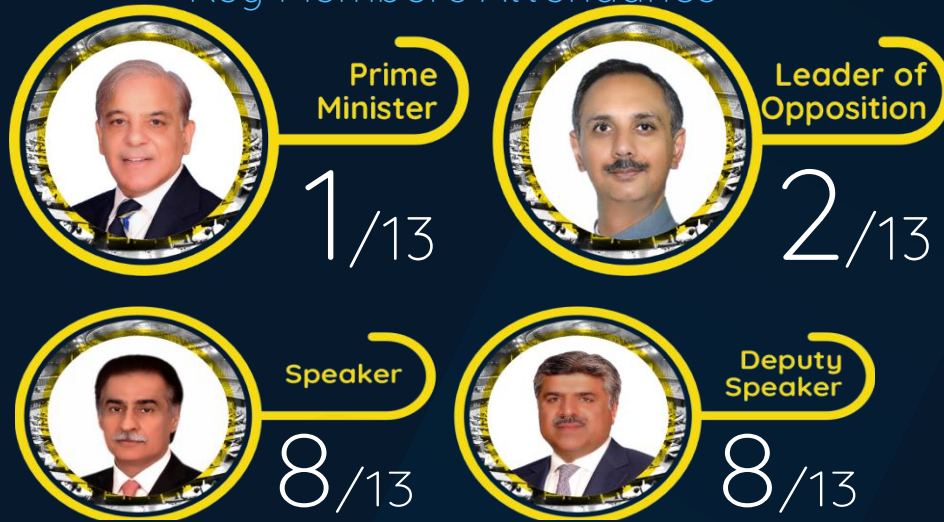


Figure 8: Attendance of State Ministers

The Federal Ministers for Parliamentary Affairs, Public Affairs Unit, and Science and Technology attended all sittings. Wherea as Minister of State for Railways, Minister of State for Planning, Development and Special Initiatives and Minister of State for Religious Affairs & Interfaith Harmony attended 10 sittings. Figures 7 and 8 illustrate the number of sittings each cabinet minister from the Lower House attended during the session, based on official attendance records available on the National Assembly website.

The incumbent cabinet comprises the Prime Minister and 31 Federal Ministers including 25 MNAs and six Senators. The cabinet members from the Senate are not ordinarily required to attend the Assembly's session unless there's an agenda item pertaining to their ministry. In addition to the federal ministers, as many as 11 MNAs hold the office of the Ministers of State and 24 of the Parliamentary Secretaries of various ministries.



Figure 7: Attendance of Federal Ministers

The Attendance Report Card of the Members of the National Assembly of Pakistan is an initiative by the Free and Fair Election Network (FAFEN) aimed at promoting transparency and accountability by making the performance of elected representatives accessible to the public. Their attendance serves as a key indicator of their commitment to legislative responsibilities, including representing their constituents, contributing to policy debates, and holding the government accountable.

This report presents a detailed analysis of MNAs' attendance during the plenary sittings of the National Assembly's 16th session, held from May 5 to May 22, 2025. It provides insights into attendance trends across regions, political parties, and gender, highlighting levels of engagement among lawmakers. The report relies on the verbatim debates for leave records of MNA.

Since 2010, FAFEN has been systematically observing and reporting on the plenary proceedings of the federal Parliament and Provincial Assemblies. These efforts have significantly contributed to enhancing parliamentary transparency and strengthening the connection between citizens and their elected representatives, fostering a more inclusive and accountable democratic process.
