01 — OVERVIEW

Overall Attendance Distribution

The 362nd session comprised six sittings between June 10 and June 18, 2026. Currently, the House has 95 members as a general seat from Khyber Pakhtunkhwa is vacant.

Attendance Category Breakdown

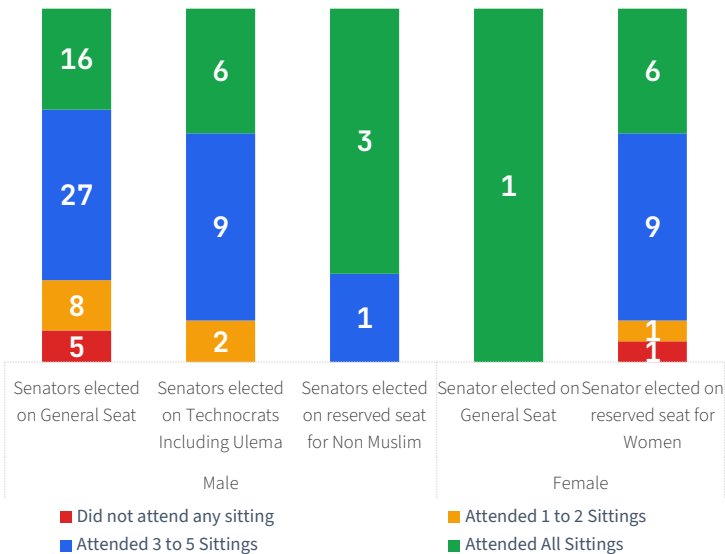

About the Report

The Report on the Attendance of the Members of the Senate of Pakistan is an initiative by the Free and Fair Election Network (FAFEN) aimed at promoting transparency and accountability by making the performance of elected representatives accessible to the public. Their attendance serves as a key indicator of their commitment to legislative responsibilities, including representing their constituents, contributing to policy debates, and holding the government accountable.

This report presents a detailed analysis of Senate's attendance during the plenary sittings of the Senate's 362 session. It provides insights into attendance trends across regions, political parties, and gender and covers the

attendance of private lawmakers and cabinet ministers. The report relies on the official attendance and leave records of Senators made available on the website of the Senate.

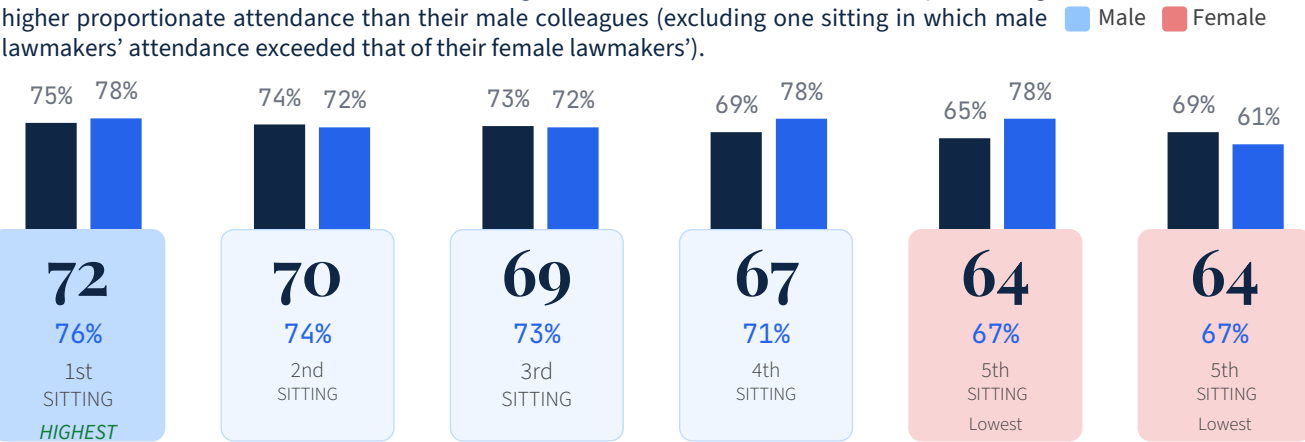

SESSION TIMELINE

Attendance Patterns by Sitting

The Senators attendance varied across six sittings with female lawmakers consistently recording higher proportionate attendance than their male colleagues (excluding one sitting in which male lawmakers’ attendance exceeded that of their female lawmakers’).



1st Sitting: The sitting addressed around 89 percent of its agenda except for Question Hour which was suspended.

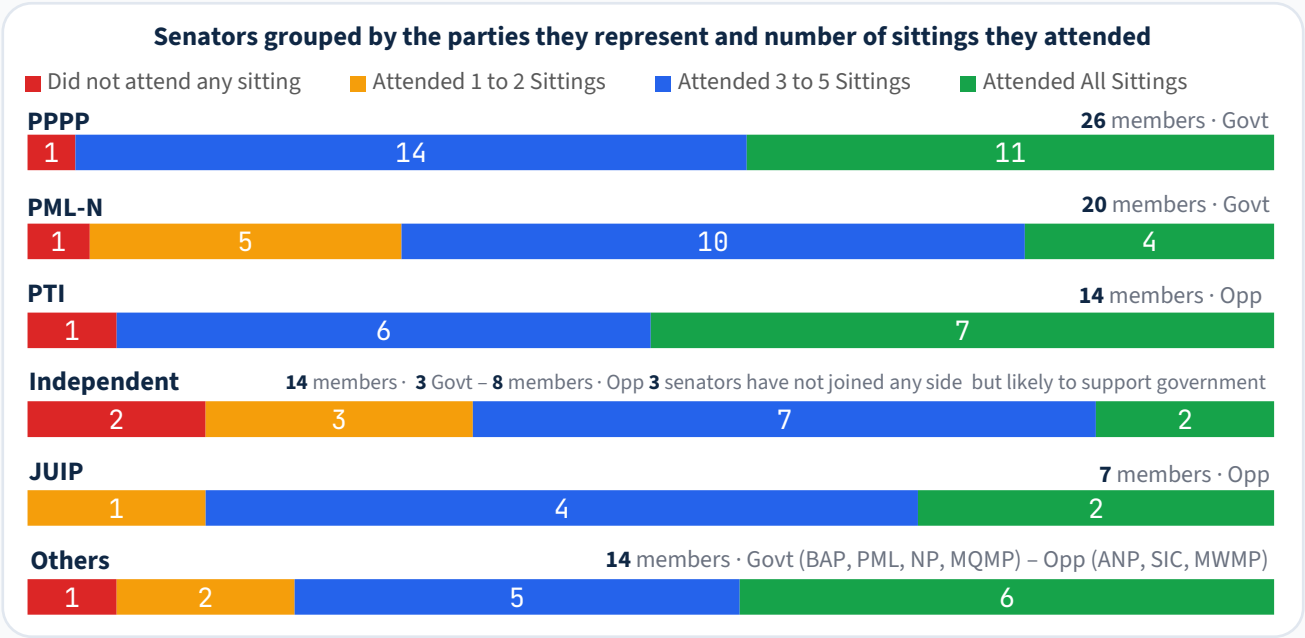

Attendance Patterns by Party

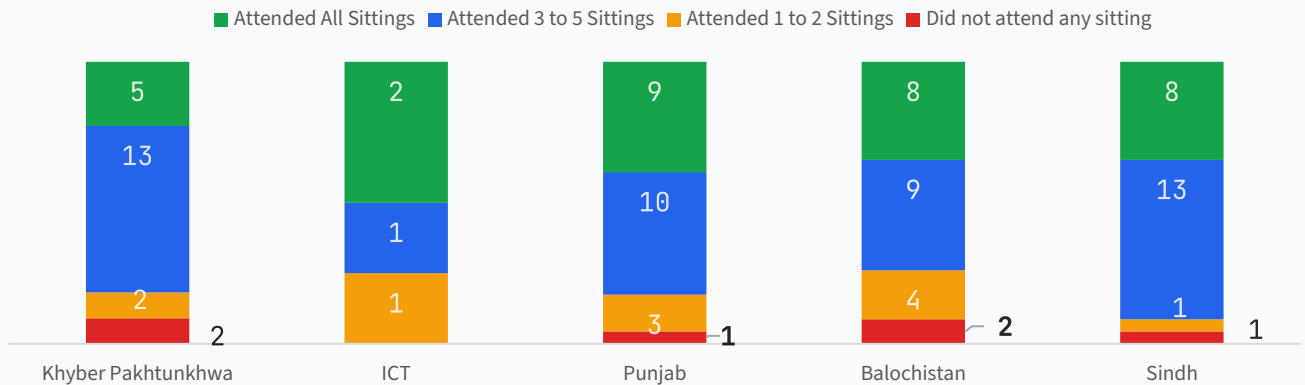
The Senate currently has 11 parliamentary parties and 14 independents. Six parties and three independents sit on government benches while five parties and three independents on opposition benches.

Leave Application Analysis

This section presents an analysis of leave requests from the 362 session.

As many as 63 members (66%) missed at least one sitting during session. Only 17 of them submitted formal leave applications, while 46 were absent without any formal request. A total of seven members submitted leave requests for earlier sessions
